A Story from a Committed Community Volunteer: Volunteering for a Cause not for Applause

Barangay Ditulan, Dumingag, Zamboanga Del Sur

Wilma F. Gaurana, 60 years old, is a resident of Purok II, Ditulan, Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur. A single parent raising her only child, Wilma once faced great uncertainties in life.

When she was still starting her married life, she spent her days as a full-time housewife, living the typical Filipino role of caring for her family. She was not actively involved in community activities because her husband disapproved. Out of love and respect, she agreed. But as years passed, raising a child alone made her realize that life was not just about the home—it was also about finding purpose beyond it.

It was during this period that she discovered the strength within her. She embraced farming as a source of living and began opening her heart to community service. What began as a way to survive became a passion for volunteerism. She first served as a barangay volunteer in Ditulan, later becoming a Purok Leader. Balancing her duties at home with her responsibilities in the community, she earned the respect of her neighbors. Her dedication and leadership led her to be elected as BDC-TWG Chairperson of the KALAHI CIDSS program, a role she embraced wholeheartedly. She also became the Federated Treasurer of the Dumingag Farmers Association, bringing pride not just to herself but also to her community.

For Wilma, volunteerism is more than a title—it is a calling. She believes a true volunteer must be driven by sincerity and commitment, not by personal gain. As she puts it:

"Ang pagka-volunteer usa ka commitment nga dapat dili lang kung kanus-a ka ganahan, pero dapat kini gikan sa kasing-kasing ug makita sa buhat, usa kini ka bug-at nga responsibilidad."

(Being a volunteer is a commitment that should not depend on mood or convenience—it must come from the heart and be seen in your actions, for it is a heavy responsibility.)

Today, Wilma continues to serve with passion, proving that age is not a barrier to making a difference. From being a full-time housewife to a single-parent leader, her journey is a testament to resilience, service, and the power of finding purpose in helping others.

What is... KALAHI-CIDSS NCDDP AF?



KALAH-CIDSS NCDDP AF



WHAT IS KALAH-CIDSS / KC-NCDDP?

KALAH-CIDSS stands for Kapit-Bisig Laban sa Kahirapan – Comprehensive and Integrated Delivery of Social Services. It's DSWD's flagship poverty-alleviation initiative that uses a Community-Driven Development (CDD) model. Established in 2003 and scaled nationally in 2013, its aim is to empower poor municipalities to reduce poverty and improve access to basic services through inclusive local planning and implementation

CORE PRINCIPLES

KALAH-CIDSS is guided by LET-CIDSS principles—meaning it is: **Localized**: Communities choose their own priorities and solutions **Empowering**: Citizens are trained and organized to lead development **Transparent**: Public monitoring through multi-stakeholder systems **Inclusive**: Participation from women, indigenous peoples, poor households and volunteers Demand-Driven, Simple, and Sustainable in structure and procedures

HOW IT WORKS

Social Preparation & Capacity Building: Communities undergo participatory training—resource mapping, planning, savings groups—to prepare them to manage projects. **Project Identification & Proposal**: Through barangay assemblies, residents identify local needs (e.g., roads, water systems, evacuation centers) and select proposals to fund. **Approval & Budget Release**: DSWD (via KC-NCDDP funds, often co-funded by the LGU) approves and releases grants in tranches directly to the community sub-project management committee

Implementation & Transparency

Communities procure, build, and monitor projects—with displays of financial and physical progress at barangay centers and assemblies

Operations & Maintenance

After completion, communities assume responsibility for sustaining and operating facilities.

Program Reach & Impact

As of 2020, KC-NCDDP has engaged over 18,700 barangays in 830 municipalities, with more than 28,400 community sub-projects, benefitting nearly 7.8 million households Accountability Research Center. Evaluations found that 93% of residents said KALAH-CIDSS responded to their top needs, and it improved access to services, poverty reduction, and local governance participation

KALAHI-CIDSS KKB CDD CRITERIA SETTING WORKSHOP

AUGUST 30, 2023

LGU Dumingag convened the Municipal Development Council (MDC) together with various stakeholders for the Criteria Setting Workshop, focusing on urgent needs identified through community-driven responses. Mayor Gerry T. Paglinawan, the legislative body, and key partners attended to show full support and to encourage barangays to carefully identify their priority projects, considering the municipality's limited funding sources. This participatory and transparent approach ensures that ongoing and future projects are well-coordinated, responsive to community needs, and free from overlaps—maximizing impact and resources for the people of Dumingag.

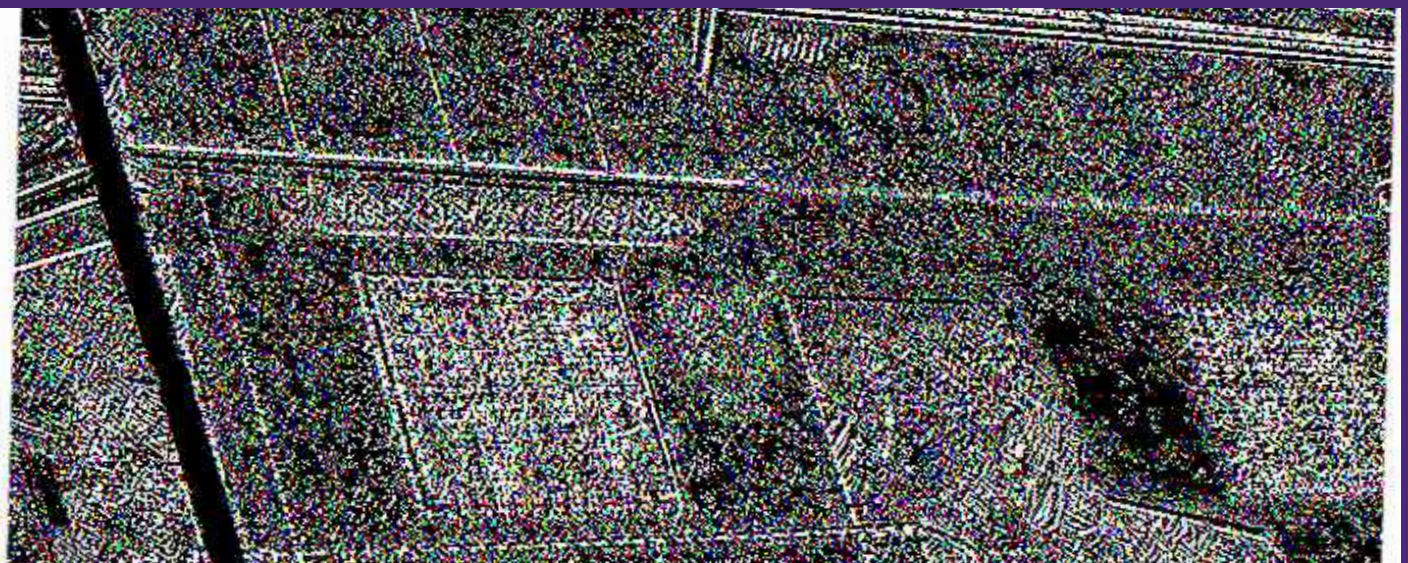
