ORDINANCE NO. 1, S. 1998

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF LGU DUMPTRUCK AND IMPOSING RENTAL FEES AND CHARGES FOR PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF." (Kag. Geographia & Kag. Faunillan)

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in so soon assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "DUMINGAG LGU DUMPTRUCK REGULATORY OR INCOME OF 1998."

SECTION 2. RENTAL FEES AND CHARGES - There shall be collected rental fees and charges for the use of the LGU Dumptruck per computation based on the distance and travel time from point of origin to respective barangays within the Municipality of Dumingag, Province of Zamboanga del Sur and other points of origin.

- 2.1 For hauling of sand, gravel, mixed sand and gravel, from from source at Gulturan river and others, rental fee shall be FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) per load for the first five (5) kilometers and an additional charge of ONE HUNDRED PESOS (P100.00) per kilometer in excess to the above-cited five kilometers;
- 2.2 The loading fee, compression fee, toll fee and/or other fees that shall be incurred in transit, shall be solely shouldered by the person or persons hiring the services of the LGU Dumptruck;
- 2.3 For hauling of materials not specified in Paragraph 2.1, Section 2 of this Ordinance, rental fee shall be FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) for or within two (2) hours travel by LGU Dumptruck from point of origin towards point of destination of the hauled materials. There shall be an additional charge of THREE HUNDRED PESOS (P300.00) per hour in excess to the two (2) hours uninterrupted travel time;
- 2.4 An advance payment of not less than FIFTY PERCENT (50%) of the estimated total amount payable shall be required of the lessee before the service of the Dumptruck be rendered.

ENFORCEMENT OFFICE- The Office of the Municipal Engineer is enjoined to enforce this Ordinance in coordination with the Philippine National Police (PNP), as the case may be.

Section 4. DESIGNATED DRIVER - There shall be a designated driver for the LGU Dumptruck, by the Local Chief Executive. Trip Tickets shall be secured by the designated driver from the Office of the Municipal Engineer for every trip of the Dumptruck, specifying therein the name of the lessee, the date and hour of use, points of origin and destination, distance in kilometers, estimated fuel and oil consumption and the kind of services rendered, to be validated by the Municipal Mayor or his/her duly authorized representative.

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Section 5. EQUIPMENT RENTAL RELEASE (ERRR)- The ERRR form shall be filled up and signed by the lessee prior to the release of the LGU Dumptruck to be secured from the Office of the Municipal Engineer.

Section 6. OFFICIAL RECEIPT - The Office of the Municipal Treasurer shall issue an Official Receipt on every payment made for the services rendered by the LGU Dumptruck, upon accomplishment of the work order and/or service bill prepared and recommended by the Municipal Engineer duly approved by the Municipal Mayor and/or his/her duly authorized representative.

Section 7. FREEDOM CHARGE - The Municipal Mayor or his/her duly authorized representative may order the use of the LGU Dumptruck free of charge to any barangay government within the municipality and/or in situations, to wit:

- 7.1 In hauling of sand and gravel, singly or mixed, or any, for the barangay-funded project. However, crude oil and other lubricants will be shouldered by the requesting barangays;
- 7.2 In case of emergencies that require the immediate transport of sick persons, injured, calamity victims, cadavers and other related cases;
- 7.3 In cases wherein the services of the LGU Dumptruck is necessary particularly in the implementation of LGU projects and programs, mobilization and in activities involving the official functions of the LGU officials.

Section 8. PENAL PROVISIONS - Any violation to the provisions of this Ordinance shall be a valid ground in the denial of the services of the LGU Dumptruck and/or if the offender is a government official or employee, he/she shall be subject for administrative or disciplinary measures.

Section 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - Any part or provision of this Ordinance which may be held invalid, the other parts or provisions thereof not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. REPEALING CLAUSE - All previous resolutions and ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby modified, repealed or superseded accordingly.

Section 11. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect after the review by the Sangguniang Pambalayan and fifteen (15) days posting at the entrance of the municipal hall.
