Ordinance No. 1, s. 2010

An Amendatory Ordinance Creating Dumingag Technological Training School (DTTS) Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur and Providing Mechanics for Implementation and Fund for its Operation therefore.

WHEREAS, as amended, Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as "The Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994", provides that the Sangguniang Bayan is mandated, subject to the availability of funds and to the existing laws, rules and regulations, to establish and provide for the operation of Vocational Technical Schools with the approval from the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) and to fix and collect reasonable fees and other school charges on the said institution subject to existing laws on tuition fees;

WHEREAS, this institution would cater to a lot of High School graduates, out of school youth and other adults in the municipality and other neighboring municipalities as well as to develop their technical knowledge and skills for personal advantage in the future;

WHEREAS, to implement the function and responsibilities of Local Government Unit to attain such vision through massive education campaign to liberate people from illiteracy, the creation and establishment of school was found necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan Members of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled; that:

Section I. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the Ordinance Creating Dumingag Technological Training School (DTTS) Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur and Providing Mechanics for Implementation and Funds for its Operation therefore.

Section II. OBJECTIVES. This Ordinance is enacted for the following objectives:

- To promote and uplift high level of Education
- To liberate people from illiteracy
- To promote additional employment
- To alleviate people from poverty through Education

Section III. MECHANICS OF IMPLEMENTATION.

- There shall be an independently owned and operated school by this LGU the "Dumingag Technological Training School" Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur
- The school shall be managed and supervised by the Municipal Economic Development Office (MEDO)
- All employees and instructors are LGU-hired
- There will be a separate bank account for the school which shall be maintained by the Municipal Treasurer and the Municipal Mayor.
- The Administrator and Trainers of DTTS will serve as a planning, implementing and monitoring body subject to the legal mandates of the Local Government Unit.
- All equipment, facilities, buildings established are owned by the LGU.

Other courses offered and corresponding fees must be determined upon amendment. All changes or increase of school fees shall be done once in every three years.

Section IV. BUDGETARY AND FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS. All salaries and wages of the items created, under this ordinance as well as its maintenance, and all other operating expenses shall be covered with appropriation of the Annual Regular Budget of the school and to be determined by the concerned personnel designated by the Local Chief Executive for the purpose.

Section V. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision of this ordinance or parts thereof declared unconstitutional or unlawful, the other parts not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

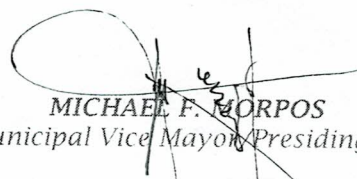
Section VI. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any parts or provision of this ordinance in conflict with or contrary to the existing ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

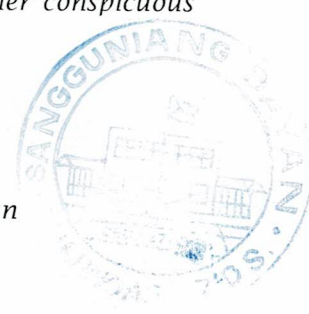
