Municipal Ordinance No. 11, s. 2015

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING JULY 1 EVERY YEAR AS MUNICIPAL ARBOR DAY, DESIGNATING PUBLIC PLACES AS TREE PLANTING SITES/AREAS, REQUIRING ALL BARANGAYS TO CELEBRATE AND DESIGNATE TREE PLANTING SITES OF ACTIVITY AND CONSTRUCT PLANT NURSERY IN THEIR RESPECTIVE BARANGAY AND PROVIDE FUNDS FOR MAINTENANCE AND GUIDELINES FOR OPERATION THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be called, "Municipal Arbor Day of Dumingag."

Section 2. LEGAL BASIS.

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10176, also known as "An Act Reviving The Observance Of Arbor Day By Authorizing The LGU The Responsibility For Celebrating The Day For The Tree Planting As An Annual Event."

This ordinance shall apply to all barangays in this municipality whose area or any government property/sites need to be reforested. It aims to:

1. reforest the denuded areas of mountains and hills
2. protect and prevent the widening of riverbank and creeks due to erosion
3. reduces soil erosions
4. increases ground water level
5. cools the environment
6. provide abode to wild animals

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

In this ordinance, word/words used are unlocked according to its uses:

- **Arbor Day** - refers to a day in which individual/groups are encouraged to go out from their houses/residence to plant and care trees.
- **MENRO** - means Municipal Environment and Natural Resources office.
- **Nursery** - refers to an area where seeds and young plants are raised or propagated.
- is a propagation area
- **Public places** - any government owned sites/areas.

Section 4. DESIGNATION OF PUBLIC PLACES.

There shall be designated public sites/areas where tree planting activities shall be done, namely:

1. Denuded part/portion of the declared protected area.
2. All government reservation areas permitted by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Office (DENRO).
3. All areas/sites identified as danger zones.
4. Landslides areas
5. Riverbanks
6. Roadsides
7. Barangay sites
8. School sites
9. Water ways

Section 5. REQUIRING PROVISIONS.

- All Barangay Officials are required to celebrate Arbor Day every first day of July and to designate public sites/areas as tree planting area during the activity.
- Individual, groups, associations, public and private schools and sectors are required to participate and join the tree planting activity.
- Every Arbor Day cleanliness drive and sanitation shall also be observed per household and or respective establishments, lots or property and premises.

Section 6. CONSTRUCTION OF BARANGAY NURSERY.

There shall be a one hundred square meters (100 sq.m.) barangay plant nursery to be constructed at a strategic location where road is accessible and water is always available. Made of indigenous light materials, a plant nursery shade or working shade shall have a dimension of twenty (20) square meters (4 meters by 5 meters), with cogon roof or any available roofing materials which shall serve as growing area for newly transplanted wildlings/seedlings. There shall be provided seed boxes for seed germination and open space inside the nursery area which shall serve as hardening area for the growing seedlings.

Section 7. MAINTENANCE OF THE PLANTED TREES AND FRUIT TREES.

The Barangay Council shall maintain the cleanliness of the standing trees/fruit trees planted during the tree planting day. Cleaning/weeding and replanting shall be done quarterly, (every three (3) months) for three (3) consecutive years per tree planting season to assure one hundred percent (100%) survival rate of the plants.

Section 8. BUDGETARY APPROPRIATION.

In order to sustain the maintenance and operation of the tree planting activity, it shall be institutionalized as an integral part of the existing program and priorities of the Barangay Local Government Unit and shall appropriate an amount sufficient for its operation.

Section 9. GUIDELINES FOR IMPLEMENTATION.

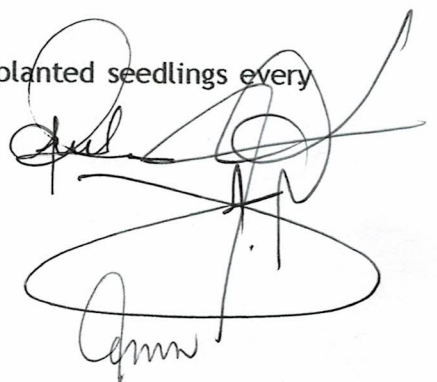
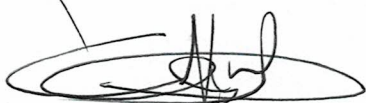
There shall be guidelines for implementation formulated as basis or guide for the tree planting activity.

A. Tree planting site/area propagation

1. Identified tree planting site/area per barangay shall be brushed/cleaned/slashed at least three (3) days before the tree planting schedule.
2. Sticking shall follow or be done one (1) day before the scheduled tree planting activity.
3. The barangay council shall provide additional area and labor force, in case shortage of cleaned area on the actual day of operation.

B. Care of Planted Seedlings and Replanting of Missing Hills

1. The barangay council shall be responsible for the weeding the planted seedlings every quarter.
2. Replanting of missing hills shall be done quarterly.
3. Same activity shall be repeated on the next year activity.



Section 10. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY.

The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officer in coordination with the Barangay Captains and Heads of Schools in this municipality shall formulate an implementing rules and policies for effective and efficient implementation of this ordinance.

Section 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any portion or section of this ordinance is declared void or unconstitutional, the remaining portions thereof shall be in full force and effect.

Section 12. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Any resolution or ordinance inconsistent hereof is hereby modified, repealed, or superseded accordingly.

Section 13. EFFECTIVITY.

This ordinance shall take effect upon the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion.

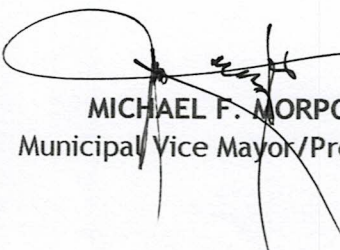

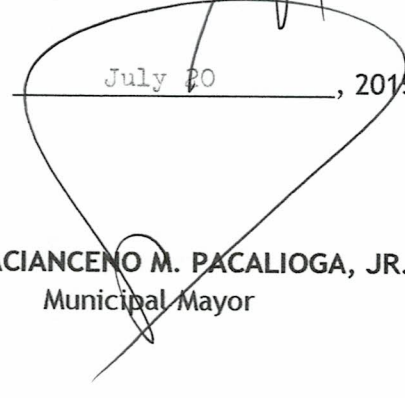
