Municipal Ordinance No. 11th-25-2024

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE DUMINGAG INSTITUTE OF SUSTAINABLE ORGANIC AGRICULTURE (DISOA) TO DUMINGAG AGRICULTURAL TRAINING SCHOOL (DATS) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance renaming the Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture (DISOA) to Dumingag Agricultural Training School (DATS)".

SECTION 2. RATIONALE

The renaming of Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Agriculture (DISOA) to Dumingag Agricultural Training School (DATS) is aimed at broadening the institution's capacity to offer a wider range of qualifications and courses. The current name limits the institution's ability to expand beyond its focus on sustainable organic agriculture, which affects the opportunities for both instructors, students and other stakeholders.

Additionally, the renaming is crucial to securing scholarship grants particularly those offered by the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA). A more inclusive name like Dumingag Agricultural Training School (DATS) reflects the institution's comprehensive approach to agricultural training courses, thereby benefiting the local community and supporting the institution's long-term sustainability.

SECTION 3. LEGAL BASIS

Section 13, Chapter 2 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to change the name of municipal public elementary, secondary and vocational or technical schools, post-secondary and other tertiary schools within its territorial jurisdiction.

SECTION 4. RENAMING

The Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture (DISOA), of this municipality, is hereby renamed to Dumingag Agricultural Training School (DATS).

SECTION 5. REALLOCATION OF BUDGETARY ALLOTMENTS

All budgetary allotments, including programs, projects and activities, intended for Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Agriculture (DISOA) shall now be reallocated or repurposed to Dumingag Agricultural Training School (DATS). This ensures that all funds, including grants and operational budgets, will be directed to DATS. The reallocation will help the school support its expanded programs and continue its mission to provide quality agricultural training.

SECTION 6. PROVISION OF ORDINANCE COPIES TO ALL STAKEHOLDERS

Copies of this ordinance shall be provided to DATS and all relevant stakeholders for their information and reference. This will ensure effective coordination and compliance in accordance with the established regulations.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other portions hereof not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE

Any portion of an ordinance, order or memorandum of local effect inconsistent with the provision/s of this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality.
