Municipal Ordinance No. 11th-3-2025

AN ORDINANCE ENSURING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE PHILIPPINE IDENTIFICATION (PHILID) OR PHILIPPINE IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM NUMBER (PSN) AS VALID PROOF OF IDENTITY FOR ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE TRANSACTIONS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in a session duly assembled, that;

SECTION 1. TITLE

This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Philippine Identification System Ordinance" in the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur".

SECTION 2. RATIONALE

This ordinance is enacted to support Republic Act No. 11055 (Philippine Identification System Act) and Executive Order No. 162, s. 2022, which establish the PhilSys ID or the Philippine Identification System Number (PSN) as the official proof of identity in the Philippines. The PhilSys ID simplifies identity verification, making it easier for people to access services and participate in government and private transactions. By adopting this system, the ordinance ensures that all residents can use their PhilSys ID for various purposes without needing additional documents.

The ordinance requires all government offices, barangays, and private entities to recognize the PhilSys ID as sufficient proof of identity and age. This reduces unnecessary paperwork, speeds up processes, and improves access to services like social benefits, financial transactions, and employment. Through this measure, the local government aims to make transactions more efficient, inclusive, and convenient for everyone.

SECTION 3. LEGAL BASES

Republic Act No. 11055, also known as the Philippine Identification System Act of 2017, an act establishing the Philippine Identification System.

Executive Order No. 162, issued on February 14, 2022 by then, President of the Philippines Rodrigo R. Duterte, institutionalizes the acceptance of the Philippine Identification or Philippine Identification System Number as sufficient proof of identity and age in all government and private transactions.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For purposes of this Ordinance, the following definition of terms are hereby adopted:

- a. Authentication refers to the process of verifying whether online or offline, the identity of an individual against the registry information in the PhilSys or PhilID.
- b. Cardholder refers to a citizen or resident alien who has been registered under the PhilSys and who has been issued and thus, in possession of the Philippine Identification Card.
- c. Personal information refers to any information whether recorded in a material form or not, from which the identity of an individual is apparent or can be reasonably and directly ascertained by the entity holding the information, or when put together with other information would directly and certainly identify an individual as defined in Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012".
- d. The PhilID is a non-transferable card issued to all citizens or resident aliens registered under the PhilSys
- e. PhilSys Number (PSN) a randomly generated, unique, and permanent identification number that will be assigned to every citizen or resident alien upon birth or registration by the PSA.
- f. PSN Derivative refers to the act of assigning a randomly generated, unique and replaceable set of identification numbers, characters, symbols or combination thereof which shall serve as a substitute to mask or represent the PSN, such as but not limited to PhilSys Card Number, PSN and/or tokens.
- g. Registered Person refers to a person who has been registered in the PhilSys.

SECTION 5. ACCEPTANCE OF PHILSYS RECORDS

The PhilSys is a government's central identification platform for all citizens and resident aliens of the country. In line with the policy under RA No. 11055, an individual's record in the PhilSys shall be considered as sufficient proof of identity and age in all public and private transactions.

SECTION 6. ACCEPTANCE OF PHILSYS IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE TRANSACTIONS

The PhilID shall serve as the official government-issued identification document and official proof of identity of cardholders in all government and private transactions in the municipality of Dumingag. Meanwhile, the PSN or PSN Derivative of an individual, as authenticated through the PhilSys, shall be honored and accepted, notwithstanding the non-presentation of the PhilID.

Unless otherwise provided by law, the presentation of the PhilID, PSN or PSN Derivative, as authenticated, shall be sufficient proof of identification and of all other personal details stated therein, without need for presentation of other identification documents. In this regard, the PhilID, PSN or PSN Derivative may be presented in lieu of a birth certificate for transactions that require individuals to establish their age. Accordingly, no additional proof of identity or age shall be required upon presentation of the PhilID, PSN or PSN derivative, as authenticated.

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This Ordinance does not prohibit the acknowledgment and acceptance of other government-issued identification documents for use in both government and private transactions.

SECTION 7. PHILSYS INTEGRATION IN THE LGU OF DUMINGAG CITIZEN'S CHARTER AND PRIVATE SECTOR REQUIREMENTS

All offices of the municipal government of Dumingag are directed to amend their respective Citizen's Charters, particularly with regards to identification requirements, to integrate the PhilSys components and accommodate its features.

Private sector entities are enjoined to inform the public of policies and guidelines on the use of the PhilID, PSN or PSN Derivative, and of similar changes in their respective identification requirements.

SECTION 8. LIMITATIONS

PhilID, PSN and PSN Derivatives, as proof of identity, shall not necessarily be construed as proof of eligibility to avail of certain benefits and services which shall be determined based on applicable rules and regulations of the government authorities/agencies concerned. It shall also not be deemed as irrefutable proof of citizenship.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, other orders and issuances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with any of the provisions in this Ordinance are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid. Other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

This ordinance shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following the completion of the posting requirements in three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality of Dumingag.

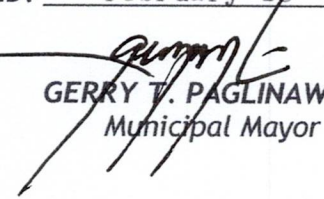

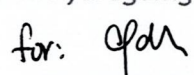
