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ORDINANCE NO. ¹⁴ 4, S. 1996

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE GOODWILL AGREEMENT MADE BY THE FLYING OR MOTORIZED AND MARKET FRESH FISH VENDORS AND ORDAINING REGULATORY PROVISIONS THEREOF. AUTHOR HONORABLE JUN PACALIOGA, CO-AUTHOR HONORABLE EDDIE BUENO AND HONORABLE EDMAN AMBIL.

WHEREAS, pending call earnestly requested by the fresh fish vendors for the resettlement of the emerging trade dispute over their sector;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan, to have once and for all settle the issue, shall make a stand by enacting an ordinance that provides goodwill measures acceptable from both conflicting sides;

NOW, THEREFORE, in session assembled by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, be it ordained that:

SECTION 1 - TITLE - This ordinance shall be called "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE GOODWILL AGREEMENT MADE BY THE FLYING OR MOTORIZED AND MARKET FRESH FISH VENDORS AND ORDAINING REGULATORY PROVISIONS THEREOF."

SECTION 2 - INTRODUCTORY CLAUSE - By the powers vested on the Sangguniang Bayan, as provided for on the Local Government Code of 1991, this ordinance mandates the adoption of the goodwill agreement made by the fresh fish vendors.

SECTION 3 - DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- a) FLYING OR MOTORIZED FRESH FISH VENDORS - travelling fish vendors in motorcycles/four wheeled vehicles who rove for customers' ease and convenience.
- b) MARKET FRESH FISH VENDORS - fish vendors stationed at specified market areas.
- c) INSIDERS - motorized fresh fish vendors who are residents of Dumingag.



d) **OUTSIDERS** - Motorized fresh fish vendors who are not residents of Dumingag.

SECTION 4 - CODE NUMBER AND COLOR CODING SYSTEM - All flying or motorized fresh fish vendors are required to adopt and implement the color coding system with the corresponding code number for proper identification. Fish boxes must be painted with colors and with the corresponding code number, as provided for in this ordinance.

A. For Dumingag - **YELLOW COLOR** and with the corresponding numbers of three digits that begin with three zeros and start to count right.

B. For **SINDANGAN** and/or for the Northwestern places - the **BLUE COLOR** and with the corresponding numbers of four digits that begin with four zeros and start to count right.

C. For the places like **PAGADIAN** and/or **Tukuran** and/or **Tangub** and/or from the Southwestern part - the **RED COLOR** and with the corresponding numbers of five digits that begin with five zeros and start to count right.

SECTION 5 - TRANSPORT PERMIT - All flying or motorized fresh fish vendors, both insiders and outsiders, are mandated to pay the annual **TRANSPORT PERMIT FEE** of **FIFTY PESOS (P50.00)** to the Municipal Treasurer.

SECTION 6 - POLICY ON OUTSIDERS - No outsiders are permitted to operate/sell business/fish without complying same requirements of the insiders such as the necessary tax payment as provided for in the Local Revenue Code of 1994 in the municipality and the regulatory provisions provided in this ordinance.

SECTION 7 - IMPLEMENTING RULES - The Municipal Treasurer, through the instruction of the Mayor, and in coordination with the Philippine National Police (PNP) shall be the frontline implementer of this ordinance. The Municipal Treasurer shall regulate the issuance of the **CODE NUMBER AND COLOR CODING SYSTEM** for synchronized disposition.

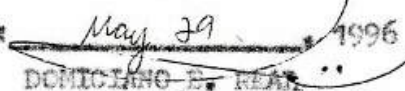
SECTION 8 - REPEALING CLAUSE - All resolutions, ordinances, or laws of local effect inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby modified, superseded or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 9 - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - Any sections or provisions of this ordinance which may be declared unlawful or unconstitutional shall not affect the other sections or provisions hereof.

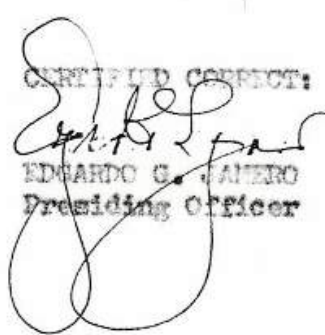
SECTION 10 - EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall be enforceable upon approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after 15 days from its publication in our municipal bulletin board.
