Ordinance No. 15, s. 1998

"AN ORDINANCE DECLARING WEDNESDAYS AND SUNDAYS AS MARKET DAY AT MABINI STREET, SAN PEDRO DISTRICT, MORE SPECIFICALLY, FROM THE CORNER OF DR. FUTALAN'S MEDICAL CLINIC STRAIGHT TO THE CORNER OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH OLD CONVENT BUILDING, INCLUSIVE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF".

WHEREAS, regular vendors inside the public market air their dissatisfaction over the existence and operations of sidewalk vendors as same affect their sales ;

WHEREAS, these regular vendors are paying for their respective stalls and other requirements with the government ;

WHEREAS, sidewalk vendors also need the help of government for them to display or sell their goods and/or products legally by giving them appropriate areas ;

WHEREAS, sidewalks are meant for people to pass by and must be cleared at all times to pave the way for the smooth flow of traffic hand in hand with proper market arrangement ;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, in session assembled, that :

SECTION 1 - This ordinance shall be called "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING WEDNESDAYS AND SUNDAYS AS MARKET DAY AT MABINI STREET, SAN PEDRO DISTRICT, THIS MUNICIPALITY, MORE SPECIFICALLY FROM THE CORNER OF DR. FUTALAN'S MEDICAL CLINIC STRAIGHT TO THE CORNER OF THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH OLD CONVENT BUILDING, INCLUSIVE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF".

SECTION 2 - This ordinance aims to give satisfaction and convenience to the constituents who do not ^{have} stalls inside the public market for them to display or sell their goods or products legally during market day ;

Section 3 - Definition of terms - For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows :

- a) Market Day - free day to all vendors, regular or non-regular, to display or sell their goods or products freely but legally.
- b) "Freely" - be opened for business free from complaints or protest from any side or party.
- c) "Legally"- all vendors whether regular or non-regular are authorized to display during said market days, as defined and described.

Section 4 - Regulatory Provisions -

- a) Sale or display of goods or products outside WEDNESDAYS and SUNDAYS is hereby prohibited.
- b) Use of SIDEWALKS for vendors to display or sell their goods is likewise not allowed.

Section 5 - Enforcement Agency -

The Office of the Municipal Mayor has the inherent authority to enforce this ordinance. The Office of the Municipal Treasurer is directed to issue cash tickets to all vendors during market days as additional income to the municipality. The Chief of Police is likewise mandated to enforce this ordinance as to supervision, proper management, arrangement and orderliness.

Section 6 - Penal Provisions -

Any person/persons found violating this ordinance shall be penalized, as follows :

- a) First Offense - A penalty of ₱200.00 or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) week, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
- b) Second Offense - A penalty of ₱300.00 or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) week, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
- c) Third Offense - A penalty of ₱500.00 or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) week, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 7 - Separability Clause - If any part or provision of this ordinance is declared inconsistent or unconstitutional, remaining portion not affected by such declaration shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 8 - Repealing Clause - Any existing resolution or ordinance which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 9 - Effectivity Clause - This ordinance shall take effect after review and approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after posting certified copies in conspicuous places in the municipality as well as at the Municipal Hall.
