Ordinance No. 16, s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING TOTAL ERADICATION OF STRAY DOGS AND
IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF."

Section 1. TITLE. "ANTI-STRAY DOG ORDINANCE OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR."

Section 2. SCOPE OF APPLICATION. This ordinance shall apply to all dog owners of this municipality.

Section 3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to totally eradicate stray dogs to keep the surroundings clean and sanitary and to prevent dog biting incidents.

Section 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS

1. *Stray dogs* - are wandering dogs roaming around in public places or streets, unclaimed.
2. *Pet dogs* - are dogs kept inside the premises of the dog owners.
3. *Exotic* - imported, rare, peculiar breed of dogs.

Section 5. MANDATORY PROVISIONS

1. All pet dog owners are mandated to monitor and always keep their pet dogs tied inside the premises/compound to prevent any dog biting incidents on individuals especially children who are vulnerable to dog bite.
2. All pet dog owners are prohibited to tether/bring their dogs outside their premises or to public places to defecate.
3. For uncaught stray dogs after 24 hrs., the PNP is mandated to kill either by poisoning or shooting them.

4. In case the dog is of exotic breed, the dog shall be endorsed to the PNP for Public auction and one half of the proceed shall accrue to the PNP and the CVO in case of the barangay and another one half accrue to the LGU or barangay treasurer in case of the barangay. If the dog is not exotic the enforcers are mandated to kill either by poisoning or by shooting them.

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES. The (PNP) Philippine National Police and deputized personnel, are mandated to enforce this Ordinance as authorized by the Municipal Mayor.

Section 7. PENAL PROVISIONS. Any pet dog owners found violating this ordinance shall be meted the following penalties.

1. 1st offense - P200.00
2. 2nd offense - fine of P1,000.00 and or 30 days imprisonment or both

Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any part or provision of this ordinance which may be declared unlawful or invalid, the remainder shall remain to be in full force and effect.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the Local Cable TV and FM stations and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of the effectivity thereof.

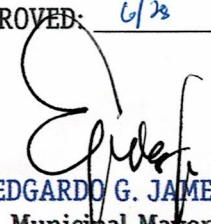
