Ordinance No. 18, s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ANY APPLICANT FOR A BUILDING PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RESIDENTIAL HOUSE TO PLANT AT LEAST FIVE TREES IN HIS/HER LAWN/GARDEN OF SAID RESIDENCE.

WHEREAS, planting fruit bearing trees and forest trees promotes the clean and green program that our Local Government Unit (LGU) wishes and tries to achieve;

WHEREAS, cutting of trees at any rate has presented a damaged and imbalanced ecology;

WHEREAS, this municipality topped the Regional award in the 4th to 6th class and Municipal level for the Cleanest and Greenest municipality;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be called " An Ordinance requiring any applicant for a building permit for the construction of a residential house to plant at least five trees in his/her lawn/garden of said residence."

Section 2. PURPOSE. For flood control, beautification, ground water stabilization, pollution control, and general environmental protection.

Section 3. SCOPE OF APPLICATION. Any applicant for a building permit for the construction of a residential house shall, before issuance of a building permit be required to plant at least five trees in the lawn, or any applicable open space in said residential lot.

Section 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this ordinance. The following terms shall mean and be understood according to their use in this ordinance.

- 4.1. *Fruit bearing trees.* These are trees that produce edible fruits such as Mango, Starapple, Jackfruit, Durian, Duhat, Santol, and other species of fruit bearing trees.

- 4.2. ¹*Forest Trees*. These are indigenous woody plants such as G-melina, Mahogany, Acasia, Ankle, Narra Almaciga, Molave and other species primarily used as limber/timber/wood.

Section 5. MECHANICS OF IMPLEMENTATION. The applicant shall declare in his/her real property declaration forms the kind and number of trees that have been planted in the appropriate spaces - If the seedling/sapling shall die, become deceased or defective, it is the obligation of the owner to replace the same immediately.

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT OFFICE. The Office of the Municipal Engineer is hereby directed to strictly enforce this ordinance.

Section 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

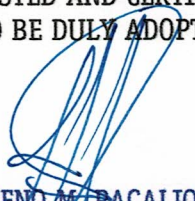
Section 8. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local Cable TV, and FM stations and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.

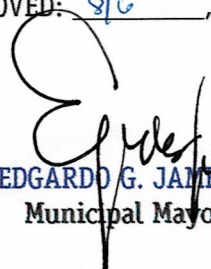
