Ordinance No. 22, s. 2001

AN ORDINANCE PENALIZING HABITUAL DRUNKENNESS IN PUBLIC PLACES
CAUSING PUBLIC SCANDAL

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, ZDS in session assembled that:

Section 1. REGULATED ACTS. No person shall engage and/or indulge in habitual drunkenness in public places thereby causing public scandal within the jurisdiction of this municipality.

Section 2. DEFINITION. As used in this ordinance:

"PUBLIC PLACES" - shall mean to include all kinds of roads, parks, plazas, cinemas, market areas, dancing halls, multi-purpose centers, terminals, stores, restaurants/carenderias and such other places open to public.

"HABITUAL DRUNKENNESS" - is a state or condition wherein a person has been engaged in drinking liquor for a considerable period of time and develop dependence on it.

Section 3. PENALTY. Violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than FIVE HUNDRED (P500.00) PESOS but not more than ONE THOUSAND (P1,000.00) PESOS or imprisonment of not less than 30 days but not more than six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 4. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The Office of the Municipal Mayor shall formulate implementing guidelines for proper implementation of this ordinance.

Section 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof where provisions are in conflict with or contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 6. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
