Ordinance No. 3, s. 2000

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING MAGSAYSAY AVENUE PARTICULARLY FROM CORNER OF SAN JOSE ST. UNTIL LALU-LAPU ST., ALL OF POBLACION, DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, AS NO PARKING AREA FOR ALL PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES FROM 6:00 A.M. UNTIL 7:00 P.M. AND NO LOADING OR UNLOADING FOR PUJs AND PUBs IN SAME AREA AND TIME AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "NO PARKING, LOADING AND UNLOADING LAW OF DUMINGAG."

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE - Pursuant to (vi), par. (5), Section 447 of RA No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Sangguniang Bayan has the power to regulate traffic on all streets within its jurisdiction. Therefore, the objective of this ordinance is to regulate the street of poblacion particularly Magsaysay Avenue in order to have a good traffic flow at the central part of the poblacion.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- a. "Parking" an act of a vehicle parked attended or unattended or permitted it to stand which the ignition switch being tuned off and the motor being stopped. For tri-sikad, stopping after thirty (30) seconds without act of loading or unloading or about to load or unload is considered parking.
- b. "Loading" an act of charging riding persons or cargoes.
- c. "Unloading" an act of discharging passengers or cargoes.
- d. "PUVs" mean public utility vehicles
- e. "PUJs" mean public utility jeepneys.
- f. "PUBs" mean public utility buses.

SECTION 4. REGULATORY PROVISIONS - It is hereby declared that the area of Magsaysay Avenue particularly from corner of San Jose St. until Lapu-lapu st., all of Poblacion, Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, as NO PARKING for all PUVs from 6:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. and NO LOADING OR UNLOADING for all PUJs and PUBs in the same time and area of the shoulder of such road or avenue.

SECTION 5. ENFORCEMENT AGENCY - The Municipal Police Station through its Traffic Officers shall strictly enforce this ordinance at all prescribed times. The Station shall

keep a logbook of the erring drivers together with the corresponding fines for monitoring purposes.

SECTION 6. PENAL PROVISIONS - Any public utility driver found guilty of violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be penalized accordingly:

a. FOR MOTOR VEHICLES

1. First Offense - a fine of fifty pesos (P50.00) or an imprisonment of five (5) days or both at the discretion of the court.
2. Second Offense - a fine of one hundred pesos (P100.00) or an imprisonment of ten (10) days or both at the discretion of the court.
3. Third and Succeeding Offenses - a fine of two hundred (P200.00) or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) month but not more than three (3) months or both at the discretion of the court.

b. FOR TRI-SIKAD DRIVERS

1. First Offense - a fine of ten pesos (P10.00) or an imprisonment of two (2) days or both at the discretion of the court.
2. Second Offense - a fine of thirty pesos (P30.00) or an imprisonment of five (5) days or both at the discretion of the court.
3. Third and Succeeding Offenses - a fine of fifty pesos (P50.00) or an imprisonment of ten (10) days or both at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any part or provision of this ordinance may be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portions not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.

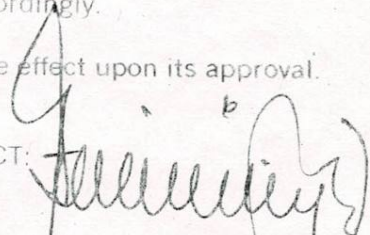

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

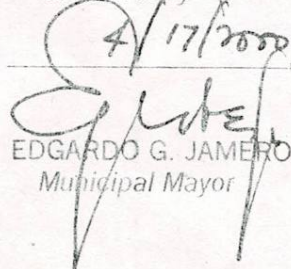
