AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AMENDATORY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 1, S. 2005 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AS MUNICIPAL POLICY THAT RECOGNITION OF POs/NGOs/CSOs FOR MEMBERSHIP OR REPRESENTATION TO ANY COMMITTEE, OR COUNCIL OR ANY SPECIAL BODY CREATED BY LAW OR INITIATED BY THE GOVERNMENT, BE GIVEN TO LGU-ACCREDITED POs/NGOs/CSOs EXCEPT THOSE AS PROVIDED BY LAW AND PROVIDING RULES AND MECHANICS FOR ACCREDITATION THEREFOR".

WHEREAS, Section 34 of RA No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Local Government Units (LGU's) shall promote the establishment and operation of Peoples Organizations, Non-Government Organizations and Civil Society Organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy and pursuant to DILG Memorandum Circular # 2007-81, there is a need to update the LGU rules on accreditation;

WHEREAS, involvement of Non-Government Organizations in the planning for development is necessary and representation or membership of NGO's to any committee, council or any special body created by law or initiated by the government will be given only to LGU-Accredited POs/NGOs/CSOs except those as provided by law;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be called, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AMENDATORY MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 1, S. 2005 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AS MUNICIPAL POLICY THAT RECOGNITION OF POs/NGOs/CSOs FOR MEMBERSHIP OR REPRESENTATION TO ANY COMMITTEE, OR COUNCIL OR ANY SPECIAL BODY CREATED BY LAW OR INITIATED BY THE GOVERNMENT, BE GIVEN TO LGU-ACCREDITED POs/NGOs/CSOs EXCEPT THOSE AS PROVIDED BY LAW AND PROVIDING RULES AND MECHANICS FOR ACCREDITATION THEREFOR".

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE. As provided for in par. (a), Section 447 of RA 7160, the Sangguniang Bayan shall enact this ordinance. Section 34 of such code provides that the LGU shall promote the establishment and operation of Peoples Organizations, Non-Government Organizations and Civil Society Organizations to become active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy. Section 108 of the same code provides that the representation to the Local Development Council and the Sangguniang Bayan shall be given to accredited POs/NGOs/CSOs subject to such criteria as may be provided by law. Therefore, this ordinance aims to accredit and recognize the POs/NGOs/CSOs for representation or membership to any committee, council or any special body created by law or initiated by the government in order to be involved in the planning geared towards development.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS OF TERMS:

- (a) Peoples Organizations - (POs) Refers to an association of residents in the barangay established to promote public interest.
- (b) Non-Government Organizations - (NGOs) Refers to an organization between the people and the state, and where the principal interest is to promote the welfare of the poor and disadvantaged.
- (c) Civil Society Organizations - (CSOs) Refers to Socio-Civic Group, Association of Professionals and Business Organization such as the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry or its Local Chamber.

SECTION 4. REGULATORY PROVISIONS.

- (a) No POs/NGOs/CSOs shall be recognized by the LGU for representation or membership to the committee or any special body created by law or initiated by the government unless accredited by the municipal government through the Sangguniang Bayan except those of automic representation as provided by law.
- (b) When two or more organization of the same kind/type whose representation or membership is provided by law, priority preference for membership or representation to any committee, council or any special body created by law or initiated by the government shall be given to duly accredited organization.

SECTION 5. RULES AND MECHANICS FOR ACCREDITATION. There is hereby established rules and mechanics for accreditation of POs/NGOs/CSOs to wit:

- (a) Within the last week of July, the Sanggunian thru the Presiding Officer, shall issue a notice of Call for Accreditation to every organization listed in the Directory of Peoples Organizations, Non-Government Organizations, Civil Society Organizations, Socio-Civic Groups, Business Organizations and Professional Groups, whether previously accredited or seeking accreditation for the first time. It shall likewise be the responsibility of the Sanggunian to see to it that:
 - 1. Copies of the notice of Call of Accreditation are prominently posted in conspicuous and publicly accessible places within the municipal hall within the last week of July and within the whole month of August.
 - 2. Application forms are readily available in the office of the Secretary to the Sanggunian.
- (b) Within the first week of August, but not later than the last working day of the said week, every Peoples Organizations, Non-Government Organizations, Socio-Civic Groups, Business Organizations or Professional Groups seeking for a new accreditation, or renewal shall submit one (1) copy each of the following requirements to the Sanggunian.
 - 1. Letter of Application
 - 2. Duly accomplished application form for accreditation
 - 3. Board Resolution signifying intention for accreditation for the purpose of representation in the local special body
 - 4. Photo copy of registration from SEC/CDA/DOLE/DSWD and any government organization and other documents necessary for the legal operation of the organization
 - 5. List of current officers and members
 - 6. Annual accomplishment report for immediately preceding year
 - 7. Financial statement (for renewing organization).
- (c) The SB Secretary shall read the application letter during the regular

and must be referred to the Committee on Accreditation for further review and study. The committee shall secure comments and recommendations from the standing committee concerned.

- (d) The Sangguniang Bayan must pass in three readings the application of POs/NGOs/CSOs for accreditation.
- (e) The LGU Accreditation must be numbered in the issuance of certificate i.e. accreditation No. 2007-1-D (2007 stands for the year of issuance, 1 is the POs/NGOs/CSOs number in the list of the accredited organizations and letter D stands for Dumingag).
- (f) The Sanggunian shall issue CERTIFICATE OF ACCREDITATION, signed by the Presiding Officer of the Sanggunian, the Chairman of the Committee on Accreditation and Municipal Mayor.
- (g) The Accreditation granted by the LGU shall be renewed every new set of Sangguniang Bayan, elected and assumed office. Any previously Accredited POs, NGOs and CSOs must renew their accreditation.

Section 6. FEES AND CHARGES. There shall be FIVE HUNDRED (P500.00) PESOS Accreditation Fee and THREE HUNDRED (P300.00) PESOS for renewal to be paid to the Municipal Treasurer.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any part of the provision of this ordinance which may be held invalid, the other parts of the provision herein not affected thereby shall remain to be in force and effect.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date thereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal hall and at least two (2) days conspicuous places in the poblacion and its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the province.
