Ordinance No. 32, s. 2001

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING EVERY CITIZEN OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR TO KEEP HIS SURROUNDINGS CLEAN AND GREEN.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance is entitled, "*AN ORDINANCE MANDATING EVERY CITIZEN OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR TO KEEP HIS SURROUNDINGS CLEAN AND GREEN*".

Section 2. PURPOSE. This ordinance is aimed at expanding and intensifying the clean and green movement of Dumingag.

Section 3. LEGAL AUTHORITY. This ordinance is enacted to supplement the provisions of an "Ordinance on Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Program for the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur" (Ordinance No. 9, s. 2001) and "Ordinance Requiring Residential House ... to Provide Their Own Container for Proper Disposal of Any Kind of Trash.." (Ordinance No. 11, s. 1998).

Section 4. MANDATORY PROVISIONS.

- 4.1. Every citizen of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur is mandated to undertake the cleaning and greening of his own yard and his immediate vicinity/surroundings including canals, shoulders of the roads and streets.
- 4.2. Barangay Chairmen, school heads, religious leaders of churches/chapels, and leasee/owners of business establishments within the municipality are also mandated to undertake the cleaning of backyards, canals, streets/roads within their immediate vicinity including those outside their fence/gate.
- 4.3. Each household is mandated to have vegetable and flower gardens, sanitary toilet, compost pit/pile for biodegradable waste and another receptacle/container

for non-biodegradable waste, and a tightly covered pit as depository of liquid waste from kitchen sink, bathroom and/or toilet should there be no outlet/canal coursed toward the main canal along the roads.

- 4.4. Each household is prohibited to burn solid waste accumulated in the vicinity.

Section 5. PENAL PROVISION. Any violation of this ordinance shall subject the offender to a fine of P100.00 for the first offense, P300.00 for the second offense and P500.00 for the third and subsequent offenses and/or imprisonment of 5 days at the discretion of the court.

Section 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any portion/section of this ordinance may be declared invalid or unconstitutional, and the remaining portions/sections hereof not affected, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after review and approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after three (3) weeks from the date copy hereof is posted in the Bulletin Board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion and further, announcement in the local Cable TV, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.
