Ordinance No. 36, s. 2002

“AN ORDINANCE CREATING DUMINGAG CONSULTATIVE FORUM”.

WHEREAS, it was customary among local legislators to draft ordinances, resolutions and other measures out of their own whim which do not address the needs of the people thus they end up lumbering into the archives of the Sangguniang Bayan Office as a lost cause ;

WHEREAS, in order to bring these encumbrances of addressing the needs of the people to a halt, there is an immediate need of involving people from every sector of society to play an active part in the formation of legislative measures befitting a highly extolled municipality ;

THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that :

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be entitled, “An Ordinance Creating Dumingag Consultative Forum.”

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. This ordinance is enacted to aid local legislators in crafting laws that address the immediate and felt needs of the populace by consulting people on the real issues and concerns of the municipality. This is a bottom-up, grassroots approach in legislation.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following term shall mean and be understood according to its use in this ordinance.

- 3.1. Consultative forum. In this ordinance, it is a group of persons chosen from among different sectors of society assembled together for a common purpose of contemplating on the issues and concerns of the municipality which may aid in the enactment of laws based on the urgent and felt needs of the people.

Section 4. MECHANICS OF CREATION AND IMPLEMENTATION

- 4.1. Composition and Representation. There shall be created the Dumingag Consultative Forum shall be composed of 20-25 members represented by the different sectors of society such as but not limited to the following: MPDC, MCR, DILG, DA, MSWD, PNP, DRHU, SB, ABC, academe, national agencies/offices, MAFC, FA, accredited/non-accredited organizations/associations/cooperatives, Federated NGOs, Women organizations, youth organizations, business sector and cultural community sector. It shall be chaired by the Municipal Vice Mayor or in his absence, any Sangguniang Bayan Member duly designated by him. He shall also act as the convenor of the forum. The number and sectoral representation in each forum shall depend on the issues and concerns and/or the legislative needs/agenda. The staff of the Office of the Municipal Vice Mayor shall serve as its secretariat.
- 4.2. Conduct of the forum. The forum shall be convened once a month at a specified time and place as agreed upon by the group.
- 4.3. Functions of Dumingag Consultative Forum. The forum shall have the following functions:

1. Formulate plan of action in support of legislative agenda of the municipality by coordinating with the different agencies/offices/individuals to gather information and data regarding their concerns and programs.
2. Advocate for the passage of ordinances and other measures in response to the issues and concerns of the municipality.
3. Assist in the dissemination of ordinances for its proper implementation.
4. Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the ordinances and of their implementation by concerned agencies/offices/individuals.
5. Recommend for the amendment or the declaration of a portion /section or of the whole ordinance as worthless or null and void or unconstitutional; and, do such as may deem necessary.
6. Such other functions as may be deemed necessary by the members

Section 5. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 5.1. The Office of the MVM shall be the implementing agency to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.
- 5.2. The representative of any sector may be changed from time to time to meet the needs of the group based on the expertise or experience of the member.
- 5.3. A member who, for any reason/cause, fails to attend for three consecutive months may be dropped from the list of representatives as may be agreed upon by the group.

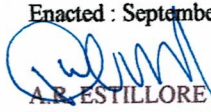
Section 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any portion of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional, other portions not affected by such declaration shall remain to be in full force and effect.

Section 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Ordinances and other measures of local application which are contrary to or in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified.

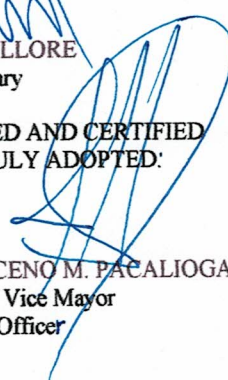
Section 8. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the Bulletin Board at the entrance of the Municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion and further, announcement in the Local Cable TV, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of the effectivity thereof.

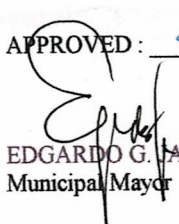
