Ordinance No. 4, s. 2004

AMENDATORY ORDINANCE DECLARING THE MUNICIPAL BREEDING CENTER AS THE BAGSAKAN/AUCTION CENTER AND MANDATING AND REGULATING THE SELLING AND BUYING OF LARGE CATTLE, HORSES, SMALL RUMINANTS, HOGS AND POULTRY, TO INCLUDE REGISTRATION, TO BE DONE ONLY AT THE MUNICIPAL BREEDING CENTER, DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AND PROVIDING PENALTY IN CASE OF VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5, s. 1972 provides the selling and buying of carabao and large cattle in general to be made and undertaken at the Municipal Building to protect the interest of the public against anomalous transactions ;

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 5, s. 1972 is found to be adversely detrimental to the present program of Clean and Green whereby the presence of large cattle at the Municipal Building during the buying and selling transactions creates unsanitary conditions per se ;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. "An Amendatory Ordinance Declaring the Municipal Breeding Center as the Bagsakan/Auction Center and Mandating and Regulating the Selling and Buying of Large Cattle, Horses, Small Ruminants, Hogs and Poultry, to Include Registration, to Be Done Only at the Municipal Breeding Center, Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur and Providing Penalty in Case of Violation Thereof."

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms are defined according to their working concepts/principles in this ordinance:

- 2.1. Hogs. Pigs or swine raised for market.
- 2.2. Horse. A large animal with solid hoofs and long mane and tail.
- 2.3. Large Cattle. Domesticated large animals such as cows and carabaos.
- 2.4. Small ruminants. They include goats and sheep.
- 2.5. Poultry. Domesticated fowls or birds such as but not limited to chicken, turkey, geese, ducks.
- 2.6. Poblacion. It covers Barangays San Pablo and San Pedro.

SECTION 3. REGULATORY ACTS:

- 3.1. No person, be he a seller or buyer, shall transact the selling or buying of large cattle, horses, goats, sheep and hogs at the Municipal Building or at any point in the poblacion except at the Municipal Breeding Center.
- 3.2. The registering officer is hereby required to register large cattle and horses only at the Municipal Breeding Center.
- 3.3. Selling and buying transaction may be done at the barangay level outside the poblacion.
- 3.4. Poultry may be sold and bought at any point of the poblacion provided, however, that the confinement by the traders/buyers of such birds waiting for transport or buyers shall be done at the Municipal Breeding Center.

SECTION 4. PENAL PROVISION. Any person, seller or buyer of animals as provided in Section 1, or registering officer of large cattle and horses, found violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) month or both at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any provision or section of any ordinance of local application found in conflict with or inconsistent to the provisions of this ordinance is deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part of the provisions of this ordinance be held invalid, the other parts or provisions thereof not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, published in a local newspaper of general circulation for a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.
