Ordinance No. 40, s. 2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 24, S. 1996 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL FOOD OUTLETS, RESTAURANTS, CARENDERIA AND STORES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG TO MAKE AVAILABLE TO CUSTOMERS ONLY THE IODIZED SALT IN THEIR RESPECTIVE ESTABLISHMENTS PURSUANT TO R.A. 8172 PROVIDING MECHANISMS IN THE ENFORCEMENT AND IMPOSING FINE FOR VIOLATION THEREOF"

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

The introductory title is hereby amended by addition to read addition as follows:

"An Amendatory Ordinance Requiring all Food Outlets, Restaurants, Carenderia and Stores within the Municipality of Dumingag to make available to Customers Only the Iodized Salt in Their Establishments and all Homes to Use the Iodized Salt in Cooking and Table Needs."

Section 1. TITLE. is hereby amended by insertion, to read as follows:

Section 1. TITLE - This ordinance shall be known as the "Iodized Salt Marketing, Promotion and Consumption Law of Dumingag"

Section 4, Paragraph b of Mechanisms of Promotion and Implementation is hereby amended by deletion and insertion to read as follows:

Section 4. MECHANISM OF PROMOTION AND IMPLEMENTATION. Paragraph (b). The Municipal Health Officer (MHO) and the Municipal Nutrition Action Officer (MNAC), or in their absence, the Sanitary Inspector with the support of the Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS) and Barangay Health Worker (BHW) in the respective barangays, shall check and monitor the quality of food-grade-salt being sold in the market and stores and being used in restaurants, carenderias and in homes in order to ascertain that salt is properly iodized and consumed.

Section 8. Sanctions: Paragraph (d) is hereby amended by substitution, to read as follows:

Section 8. Sanctions: Paragraph (d) Fines collected shall accrue to the coffer of the Municipality for its use in the implementation of the "Asin Law." (R.A. 8172).

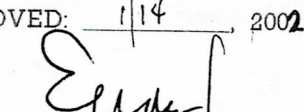
