Ordinance No. 42, s. 2001

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL PRIVATE AND PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES SUCH AS BUT NOT LIMITED TO TRUCKS, BUSES, JEEPNEYS, VANS, AUTOMOBILES, PICK-UP, THREE- WHEELED VEHICLES, TWO-WHEELED MOTORCYCLES AND MOTORIZED TRICYCLES TO INSTALL SILENCERS TO PREVENT NOISE POLLUTION.

Section 1. TITLE. The title of this ordinance shall be called, "Anti-Sound Pollution Law of Dumingag."

Section 2. PURPOSE. This ordinance is aimed at minimizing, if not totally eradicating pollution caused by noise emitted by any vehicles which may hamper or injure the auditory system of individuals.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

3.1 Extenuating or aggravating circumstances - Situations or conditions as factors or reasons which partly excuse a bad situation or wrong action.

3.2. Noise pollution - any discharge of excessive sound into the atmosphere beyond the necessary decibel that will or is likely to injure the auditory system of an individual.

Section 4. MANDATORY REGULATIONS.

4.1. Owners/operators of all vehicles are mandated to install silencers to minimize noise pollution.

4.2. No vehicle shall be allowed to rove unless such vehicle complies with or conforms to the silencer installation requirements.

4.3. The owner/operator/driver of the vehicle found violating this ordinance is required to install silencer within 15 days from the date of apprehension and show proof of compliance before the vehicle can be allowed to be driven on any public or subdivision roads.

Section 5. PENAL PROVISIONS. Any person who fails to comply with the provision of this ordinance shall be meted the following penalties:

5.1. Any owner/operator/driver who willfully violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be warned for the first offense, P50.00 for the second offense and P100.00 for the third offense or an imprisonment of two (2) days

upon the discretion of the court. In the absence of any extenuating or aggravating circumstances, the amount of fine for negligence shall be equivalent to one-half of the fine for willful violation.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after review and approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after three weeks from the date copy hereof is posted in the Bulletin Board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two other conspicuous places in the poblacion and further, announcement in the local Cable TV, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.
