Ordinance No. 5, s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE FIXING RATE ON BUSINESS TAX AND MAYOR'S PERMIT FOR PUBLIC TELEPHONE/CELLPHONE OPERATORS TO INCLUDE CALLING CENTERS/OFFICES IN DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be called as "An ordinance fixing rate on business tax for public telephone/cellphone operators including calling centers/offices in the municipality of Dumingag."

Section 2. TAX ON BUSINESS. There shall be imposed a fixed business tax on operators of Public Telephone in the amount of P1,000 per year.

Section 3. MAYOR'S PERMIT. Any business application and/or renewal of public telephone operators shall be charged the amount of P500 for Mayor's Permit fee yearly.

Section 4. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The Municipal Mayor through the recommendation of the Municipal Treasurer's Office shall formulate implementing guidelines for proper implementation of this ordinance.

Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any section or provision of this ordinance may be declared unlawful or invalid, the remainder of such declaration shall remain to be in full force and effect.

Section 6. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM station and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of the effectivity thereof.

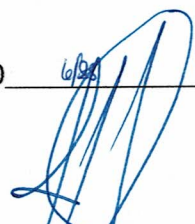
