Ordinance No. 6, 2003

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING TRI-SIKAD OWNERS OR OPERATORS OPERATING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG TO RENT THEIR TRI-SIKAD ONLY TO THE QUALIFIED AND DULY LICENSED DRIVER AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, measures, ways and means were already crafted just to prohibit minors and illegal drivers to drive the tri-sikad ;

WHEREAS, minors and other adults are still seen driving even without permit to drive ;

WHEREAS, owners of the tri-sikad also rent their tri-sikad units to minors and adults without verifying the qualification to drive ;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled that :

Section 1. Title. "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING TRI-SIKAD OWNERS OR OPERATORS OPERATING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG TO RENT THEIR TRI-SIKAD ONLY TO THE QUALIFIED AND DULY LICENSED DRIVER AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF."

Section II. Scope and Purpose. This ordinance shall apply only to tri-sikad owners who operate in this municipality for the following purposes :

1. To minimize the case of illegal drivers including minors
2. To win the trust and confidence of the riding public

Section 3. Definition of Terms. For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms are defined :

1. *Qualified drivers* – refers to the following :
 - a. 18 years old and above
 - b. possesses permit/license to drive
 - c. physically healthy and mentally sound
2. *Minors* – refers to children below 18 years of age and are not qualified to be issued a permit/license to drive.
3. *Illegal adult drivers* – persons who have no permit or are not issued permit to drive

Section 4. Mandatory Measures

1. It is hereby mandated that tri-sikad owners or operators require the applicant to present pertinent papers or documents such as permit or license to drive before renting the tri-sikad out to the driver applicant.
2. Tri-sikad owners rent to drivers only who can present I.D.

1. *First offense* – A fine of five hundred pesos and impounding of the tri-sikad and payment of impounding fee of P50.00
2. *Second offense* – A fine of One Thousand Pesos plus impounding of the tri-sikad and payment of impounding fee of P50.00
3. *Third and subsequent offenses* – Impounding of the tri-sikad and cancellation of the business permit and fine of P1,500.00.

Section 6. Enforcement Agency. The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Philippine National Police shall be the enforcement agency for the strict implementation of this ordinance. Treasurer's Office shall be tasked to issue OR for the purpose of collecting fines/fees. The Tri-sikad Association in coordination with the Philippine National Police shall be given the task to implement this ordinance.

Section 7. Repealing Clause. Any provision found to be inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed, modified accordingly.

Section 8. Separability Clause. Any provision, or part hereof, is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the ordinance not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

Section 9. Effectivity and Publication Clause. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM station and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.
