Ordinance No. 8, s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GENERAL POLICIES AND REGULATIONS ON CHILD LABOR AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION, WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7610, provides stronger deterrence and special protection against child abuse, exploitation and discrimination; and,

WHEREAS, R.A 7658 prohibits the employment of children 15 years of age below in public and private undertakings, amending for this purpose section 12, article V111 of R.A. 7610,

WHEREAS, RA 7658 further prohibits the employment of children 18 years below for any hazardous labor;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Dumingag is known to be "Child friendly;

WHEREAS, there is still a need to augment this campaign in our beloved municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag in session assembled, that;

Section 1. TITLE. This shall be known as "An Ordinance Providing General Policies and Regulations on Child Labor within the Municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur."

Section 2. DECLARATION OF MUNICIPAL GENERAL POLICY AND REGULATIONS.

It is hereby declared to be the policy of this municipality to ensure children welfare and avoid conditions in child labor prejudicial to their development; to be strong in the carrying of programs protecting the children that this municipality shall monitor closely and effectively and act accordingly by intervening on behalf of the child against Child Labor as provided for by R. A. No. 7658, Section 1.

Section 3. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The office of the Municipal Mayor shall formulate Implementing Rules and Regulations, through the recommendations of the office of MSWDO, the PNP, the academe, NGOs and POs.

¹Section 4. PENAL PROVISIONS. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall be penalized an amount of not less than One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) but not more than Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) or imprisonment of not less than three (3) months but not more than three years, or both at the discretion of the court.

Section 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any section/provisions found to be inconsistent with this ordinance shall be repealed accordingly.

Section 6. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM station and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.

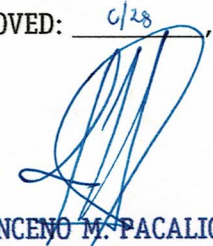
