AN AMENDATORY ORDINANCE FIXING THE SPEED LIMIT OF ALL KINDS OF MOTOR VEHICLES RUNNING WITHIN THE IDENTIFIED STREETS/ROADS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AND PROVIDING PENALTIES IN CASE OF VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that

Section I. TITLE

This Amendatory Ordinance shall be called "An Amendatory Ordinance Fixing the Speed Limit of All Kinds of Motor vehicles running within the identified streets/roads in the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur and providing penalties in case of violation thereof.

Section II. PURPOSE

This ordinance is aimed to reduce/limit if not totally prevent vehicular accident because of speed and reckless driving in which the children are most often the victims.

Section III. SCOPE OF APPLICATION

This ordinance shall apply to all kinds of motor vehicles such as but not limited to motorcycle, motorized tricycle, bus, van, pre and post harvest facilities, multicabs, cargo trucks (panel), dump trucks and all other vehicles either for public and personal use.

Section IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS

In this ordinance the following terms shall mean

- Speed limit** – is the maximum speed allowed by this ordinance for road vehicles
- Motor vehicles** – is a machine which incorporates a motor (sometimes known as engine) and which is used for transportation.
- Poblacion** – refers to the "town center" that comprises the municipal streets namely:
Magsaysay Avenue, Sikatuna St., Mango Avenue, Quezon Blvd., Jose Abad Santos St., Copper St., De Oro St., Lapu-lapu St., San Pedro St., Rizal St., Plaridel St., Isidoro E. Real, Sr. St., Mabini St., Pioneer St., Dagohoy St., Laurel St., Quezon Blvd extension., Sikatuna Extension, De Oro extension and Juan Luna St.

Section V. REGULATORY PROVISIONS

- All drivers of motor vehicles shall limit their speed within the identified streets/road in the Poblacion in the range from 20-30 kph and 30-40 kph.
- No person, be it the owner or driver of motor vehicles is allowed to run more than the limit set in this ordinance starting from the following entry points, to wit:

➤ **20-30 kph**

- Pelayo Residence - junction of Barangay Caridad going to JHSC
- De Jose Residence - Magsaysay Avenue
- De Oro Extension - Mosqueda Lot going to JHSC
- Geographia Residence - junction of Jose Abad Santos and Mango Avenue
- Figuracion Residence - junction of San Jose St., and Jose Abad Santos, St.

- Dumingag National High School - junction of Sitio Curvada and Quezon Blvd. Extension
- Romande Lumberyard - junction of corner San Jose St., and Quezon Blvd.
- Alfarero Lumberyard - junction of Copper St., and Quezon Blvd.

➤ **30-40 kph**

- from Guitran bridge to junction of Barangay Caridad
- from Dumingag National High School to Municipal Agricultures Office

- The enforcer shall issue a citation ticket to the erring motorist. The enforcer or his duly authorized representative shall accompany the erring motorist to the Office of the Municipal Treasurer for the payment of the corresponding penalty.
- The Office of the Municipal Mayor shall be responsible in the preparation and installation of signages in relation to the implementation of this ordinance.

Section VI. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES

The Municipal Mayor through the recommendation of the Philippine National Police shall formulate the implementing guidelines for the proper implementation of this ordinance.

Section VII. ENFORCING AGENCY

The Office of the Municipal Mayor, Philippine National Police (PNP) are tasked to enforce this ordinance round-the-clock.

Section VIII. PENALTY CLAUSE

Any person/persons be it the owner or driver of motor vehicle caught violating this ordinance shall be punished in the following manner.

<i>First offense</i>	-	P 500
<i>Second offense</i>	-	P 1,500 or 3 days imprisonment
<i>Third offense</i>	-	P 2,500 or 1 week imprisonment

Section IX. REPEALING CLAUSE

All other ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

Section X. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE

This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after 15 days from the date copy thereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance places in the Poblacion and its publications in a newspaper of general circulation in the province.
