ORDINANCE NO. 9, s. 1999

"AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL SOUND SYSTEM, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ITS USAGE AND OPERATIONS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR."

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumanog, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled :

Section 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known and cited as "DUMANOG MUNICIPAL SOUND SYSTEM LAW OF 1999."

Section 2. PURPOSE - This Ordinance aims to procure and establish facilities/accessories for Municipal Sound System with proper usage and operations for programs or activities initiated by the Municipal government and for other purposes.

Section 3. ESTABLISHMENT OF MUNICIPAL SOUND SYSTEM - There is hereby established a Municipal Sound System upon procurement of complete sound facilities/accessories which shall be fixed or stored at the space to be called as "MASTER CONTROL ROOM," to be provided by the municipal government.

Section 4. DESIGNATED MASTER CONTROLLERS/OPERATORS - There shall be designated/appointed by the municipal mayor at least two (2) master controllers/operators, to officially and exclusively operate the Municipal Sound System. There shall be created (2) items for such nature of work to be included in the plantilla of personnel of the Local Government Unit (LGU) through a separate ordinance.

Section 5. PERMIT TO USE - There is hereby called a "PERMIT TO USE", to be issued by the office of the municipal mayor to any individual or group, upon presentation of formal letter of application, stating thereon the date and purpose of using the Municipal Sound System. Such PERMIT shall not be issued unless payment of the required fee has been made to the office of the municipal treasurer except on religious rally/program.

Section 6. REGULATORY PROVISIONS - For purposes of this Ordinance, proper usage and operations of the Municipal Sound System shall be governed by the following rules and regulations.

- (a) The operations of the Municipal Sound System shall be under the Office of the Municipal Mayor. The Committee on Public Utilities, Transportation and Communication of the Sangguniang Bayan may supervise the System, in coordination with the municipal mayor, for smooth operation. The designated/appointed master controllers/operators shall exclusively operate the equipments of the Municipal Sound System and no other person is allowed to do the same. In case of failure of the designated/appointed operators to do so, due to justifiable cause(s), the municipal mayor may temporarily assign a knowledgeable employee(s) of the municipal government.
- (b) The Municipal Sound System (MSS) shall be used and operated purposely to assist programs or activities initiated by the municipal government, upon instruction by the municipal mayor. From time to time, upon installation of a centralized sound effect to different offices, the System might be a channel of informations and contemporary music.
- (c) The MSS shall not be transferred to any area other than the designated area of storage for any activity or program which shall be fixed or stored in a building or space constructed for the purpose.
- (d) The MSS may be used and operated for any legal gathering activity or program other than initiated by the municipal government, provided, however, that "PERMIT TO USE" must be secured from the office of the municipal mayor.
- (e) Religious rallies by any denomination shall at all times be granted a "PERMIT TO USE" without any fee required or to be totally FREE. However, they are required to assist the designated/appointed operators in the preparation of the sound system especially in the placement of big boxes (baffles).

Section 7. PRESCRIBED FEES - There are hereby prescribed fees to any applicant for PERMIT TO USE according to the nature of program or activity to wit :

- (a) Closing Exercises - TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P 200.00)
- (b) NGO/PO initiated program/activity - TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00)
- (c) Free Program of entertainment by any individual or group -
TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00)
- (d) Program/activity by national and provincial governments -
TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00)
- (e) Benefit dance/program/activity where lights are hired from outside -
(P700.00) TWO HUNDRED PESOS.
- (f) Any program or activity not clearly specified herein, the required fee shall not be less than TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) but not more than TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) upon the discretion of the municipal mayor.

Section 8. ENFORCEMENT OFFICE - The Office of the Municipal Mayor is hereby mandated to strictly enforce this Ordinance at all times.

Section 9. PENAL PROVISION - Any public official or employee who violates this Ordinance may be meted administrative disciplinary action.

Section 10. APPROPRIATION - There is hereby appropriated an amount of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P250,000.00) for procurement of sound facilities/accessories for the establishment of Municipal Sound System, as reflected in the twenty percent (20%) EDF for CY 1999. An amount of FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P5,000.00) is hereby appropriated per annum for the maintenance thereof which shall reflected every year in the annual budget, effective for CY 2000.

Section 11. SEPA ABILITY CLAUSE -- Any part or provision of this Ordinance which may be held invalid, the other parts or provisions hereof not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 12. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE -- This Ordinance shall take effect after the review by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and three (3) consecutive weeks posting at the entrance of the municipal hall.

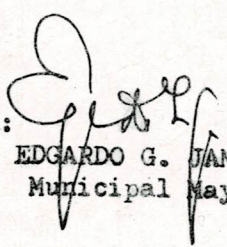
