Ordinance No. 9, s. 2009

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF TONSORIAL AND BEAUTY ESTABLISHMENT IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Tonsorial and Beauty Establishments in the Municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur."

Section 2. SCOPE AND PURPOSE.

2.1. **Scope.** This ordinance applies to barber shops beauty parlors/salons, hair and hair dressing salons, manicuring, pedicuring and spa establishments, tattooing and skin piercing shops and similar establishments, and figure slenderizing salons that include figure and slimmer salons, physical fitness salons/clubs, aerobic centers/clubs and similar establishments and individuals who provide name service of similar trade or occupation except establishment and individuals licensed professionally to perform or practice medical/surgical procedures.

2.2. This ordinance is enacted in order to prevent transmission of diseases from one customer to another.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following are defined operationally to give further clarification of this ordinance.

3.1. **Barber.** An individual whose occupation is cutting/trimming, styling and dyeing of hair, beard, moustache, eyebrows and other body hair and performing other related services to male customers.

3.2. **Barber Shop.** Place of business of a barber.

3.3. **Beautician/Hairdresser/Hairstylist/Make-up Artist.** An individual who engages in shaving, cutting, trimming, styling, waving/curling, staining/dyeing; also an individual who performs the treatment of scalp and face, manicure, pedicure, or who treats the head, scalp, face hands, skin fingernails, toe nails or feet; the term does not include medical,

paramedical and allied practitioners while in the conduct of his profession.

3.4. Desinfection. The process of eliminating or reducing to a safe levels the number of potential infection microorganisms on an item or surface by either thermal or use of chemical disinfectant solution.

3.5. Tonsorial and Beauty Establishments. It includes barbershops, beauty parlors, hairdressing and manicuring establishment and figure slenderizing salons, and other similar establishments.

Section 4. REGULATORY PROVISIONS.

4.1. No tonsorial or beauty establishment shall open and operate for public patronage without a sanitary permit issued by the Municipal Health Officer.

4.2. The place where the business is held shall be clean at all times.

4.3. There shall be a provision of a clean wash basin and soap, nailbrush and clean towels.

4.4. All establishments and those doing name service shall be required to provide a first aid kit for accidents and any sterile materials that may be used to stops flaw of hood in cases of wounds.

4.5. No pet/domestic animals shall be allowed inside the establishments.

4.6. It is strictly prohibited for a barber/beautician/customers to smoke inside the establishment a "No Smoking" sign shall be posted conspicuously in the designated area of establishment.

4.7. Every barber/beautician shall thoroughly cleanse his/her hands with water and soap or anti-bacterial agent immediately before and after serving each customer.

4.8. No person with infections disease shall work or be permitted to work in the establishment.

4.9. No barber/beautician shall be allowed to reuse towel, neck band and similar material. A separate clean towel. Paper, cloth, etc. shall be used for each customer.

5.0 All used supplies/equipment/materials shall be washed with soap and water and immersed in a disinfectant solution before serving the next customer.

5.1. Towels, linen cloths, aprons, or wraps and other washable fabrics must be immersed in disinfectant solution or soaked in water at 71.

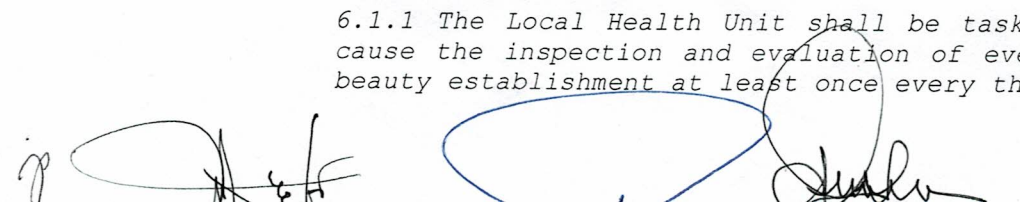
5.2. All others equipments that can immersed in a disinfectant solution shall be washed thoroughly before immersing them.

5.3. There must be adequate receptacles for the storage of waste material and shall be disposed daily.

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT PROVISION.

6.1. The Local Health Unit

6.1.1 The Local Health Unit shall be tasked to inspect or cause the inspection and evaluation of every tonsorial and beauty establishment at least once every three months.



6.1.2 The Municipal Health Office shall issue a mission order to take Sanitary Inspection who shall inspect the establishment and if found not complying with the provision of this ordinance, shall be served notice. In the event of no compliance after two sanitary orders and after two sanitary orders and after a hearing, the MHO may recommend revocation of the permit if non-compliance is not excusable.

6.2. The Local Government Unit

6.2.1. The Local Government Unit shall strengthen the regulating function of the Municipal Health Office.

6.2.2 The PNP shall be tasked to enforce this ordinance.

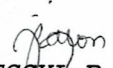
Section 7. PENAL PROVISION. Any person found violating this ordinance shall violate, disobey, omit or neglect to with any provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment for a period not exceeding P 1,000.00 or both depending upon the discretion of the court.

Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. In the event that any action, paragraph, sentence, clause or word of this ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, the other provisions thereof shall not be affected thereby.

Section 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance or portion thereof which is inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

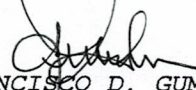
Section 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks and/ or posted in the municipal hall of all municipalities within the province.

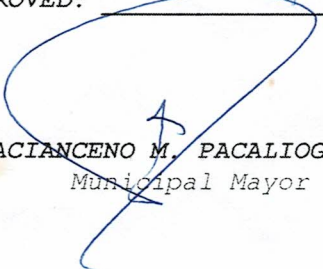
