Municipal Ordinance No. 13, s. 2015

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PASTURE AREA, PROVIDING STABILIZATION FUND AND MECHANICS FOR IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section I. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be called "An ordinance establishing pasture area, providing stabilization fund and mechanics for implementation thereof."

Section II. SCOPE AND PURPOSE:

This ordinance shall apply only to the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur and enacted to supplement Ordinance No. 11, s. 2014, "An Ordinance Regulating The Slaughter Of Young, Productive And Serviceable Carabaos, Selling The Same To Non-Resident In This Municipality And Providing Penalties For Violation Thereof," to satisfy/meet the need of the farmer in case no buyer is available during the time of emergency need.

Section III. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

- **Stabilization fund** - is an amount appropriated by the Local Government Unit (LGU) intended to buy/purchased young, serviceable and productive carabao, in case no resident buyer/co-farmer will buy the said carabao in the time of the emergency need of the owner/farmer.
- **Forage** - food for domestic animals, especially when taken by browsing or grazing.

Section IV. STABILIZATION FUND.

There shall be a stabilization fund appropriated by the Local Government Unit (LGU) in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P200,000.00) per annum intended for buying the young, productive and serviceable carabao, in case no resident buyers or co-farmer is willing to buy during the emergency need of the owner of the said carabao. This appropriation shall be included in the Annual Budget/year.

Section V. MECHANICS FOR IMPLEMENTATION.

There shall be a mechanics crafted for proper implementation of this ordinance.

1. There shall be an amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos allocated for the purpose of buying/purchasing young serviceable and productive carabaos which shall be appropriated annually.
2. The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Office of the Treasurer shall be authorized to buy/purchase the young, serviceable and productive animals and shall be brought to the pasture area at Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture (DISOA), for possible preservation, conditioning, proposal for dispersal program and reproduction purposes.
3. There shall be an area not more than five (5) hectares to be developed as grazing area planted with grasses, legumes and other similar forages intended for the purchased livestock.
4. The pasture area shall be fenced with five (5) strands barbed wire with concrete posts. Perimeter fence shall be planted with trees in between posts, which shall serve as post in the future.
5. The whole area shall be subdivided into paddocks, and each paddocks shall be provided with shade with the floor area of three (3) by six (6) square meters (8 sqm.)

6. The grazing area shall not only be limited to carabaos, but to all livestock including small ruminants and poultry as long as it is Local Government Units (LGU's) property.
7. The Municipal Agriculture and Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture personnel shall formulate program for dispersal, reproduction dairy and disposal of the animals, especially the carabaos, to be recommended to the Municipal Mayor for approval.

Section VI. IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES:

The Office of the Municipal Mayor shall formulate an implementing rules and regulation for strict and proper implementation of this ordinance thru an Executive Order which shall be issued for this purpose.

Section VII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE:

Any provision of this ordinance or parts thereof declared unconstitutional or unlawful, the other parts not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section VIII. REPEALING CLAUSE:

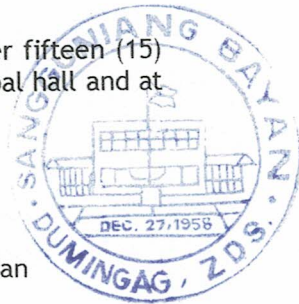
Any parts or provisions of this ordinance in conflict with or contrary to the existing ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section IX. EFFECTIVITY:

This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion.
