Municipal Ordinance No. 18, s. 2015

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ORGANIC TRADING POST IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, PROVIDING GUIDELINES AND STABILIZATION FUNDS FOR ITS OPERATION THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section I. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be called "An ordinance establishing Organic Trading Post in the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, providing guidelines and stabilization funds for its operation thereof."

Section II. PURPOSE.

This ordinance is enacted to assist the organic farmers in this municipality especially in marketing their farm products. This is to assure that farm products displayed in the Organic Trading Post is absolutely certified Organic.

Section III. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

- *Organic Trading Post* – a structure o building wherein business of agricultural organic products are being displayed.
- *Organic Farm Products* – are farm products produced without using/applying artificial fertilizers or pesticides;
 - Biologically grown and produced or ecologically grown.
- *Organic* – grown without the use of artificial fertilizers or pesticides; biological or ecological.

Section IV. GUIDELINES FOR OPERATIONS.

There shall be guidelines crafted for the proper implementation and operation of this establishment.

1. There shall be established an organic trading post of the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur.
2. Organic farm products of the organic farmer shall be certified by the Certifying Officer of this municipality before transporting to the Organic Trading Post.
3. Organic certifiers are required to certify correctly the farm products produced by our organic farmers.
4. There shall be assigned certifiers per barangay to assist the call of our organic farmers especially in certifying their farm products.
5. Unsold organic products displayed during Sundays and Market days shall be sold to the Organic Trading Post through the Municipal Treasurer.

6. The Municipal Mayor shall hire laborers and workers of the Organic Trading Post under the supervision of the Municipal Treasurer.
7. The Office of the Municipal Mayor shall designate the Municipal Treasurer as an overseer over the hired workers of the Organic Trading Post.

Section V. APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.

There shall be an appropriated amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P200,000.00) which shall serve as stabilization fund to be used as initial capital/ investment in the operation of the Organic Trading Post.

Section VI. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

Any provision of this ordinance or parts thereof declared unconstitutional or unlawful, the other parts not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section VII. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Any parts or provisions of this ordinance in conflict with or contrary to the existing ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section VIII. EFFECTIVITY.

This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion.

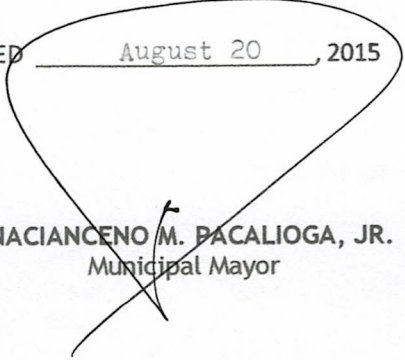
