Municipal Ordinance No. 2, s. 2016

AN ORDINANCE UPGRADING THE BARANGAY MACASING HEALTH CENTER TO BIRTHING FACILITY AND DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, OPERATIONS AND ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, as per DOH Advisory No. 02 issued on May 03, 2006 and as per 2004 report of UNFPA in the state of the population ten years after the Cairo Consensus on the International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD) Programmed Action, obstetric complications are still the leading cause of death for women of reproductive age in developing countries today.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16 of R.A. 7160 which mandates that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 17 part A and B 2.III of R.A. 7160 also mandates that every local government unit likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other function and responsibilities as are necessary appropriate or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities to health services which include the implementation or programs and project ts on primary health care maternal and child care so forth.

Section 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as the “Upgrading the Barangay Macasing Health Center to Birthing Facility and Defining its Functions, Operations and Administration”.

Section 2. PURPOSE.

To provide quality birthing services, to ensure the safety of both mother and child from CADT and non-CADT Barangays in the municipality.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

- **BEmONC** - Basic Emergency Obstetrics and Neonatal Care
- **BEmONC Medical Team** - this is a group composed of three persons; the MHO, regular Nurse, regular Midwife who were trained on BEmONC to handle and supervise deliveries at the birthing facility.
- **BF** - Birthing Facility
- **Abnormal Case** - any birth deliveries that are not considered normal delivery.
- **CADT** - Certificate of Ancestral Domain Title

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- **Casual Worker** - Casual of job order worker assigned to (MHO) RHU who is non-medical worker.
- **Casual Midwife/Nurse** - a licensed midwife/nurse who is employed as casual or job order.
- **DOH** - Department of Health
- **Emergency Transport System** - a motorcycle purposely providing critical care to patient from residence to birthing facility.
- **Indigenous People** - Subanen people who live in the CADT or Non-CADT areas of the municipality.
- **Indigent** - a patient who is duly registered below poverty line.
- **MBF** - Macasing Birthing Facility
- **MHO** - Municipal Health Officer
- **Midwife** - a licensed midwife who is duly employed as regular and permanent or group appointment.
- **MSWD** - Municipal Social Welfare and Development
- **MCP (Maternal Care Package)** - is a benefit package to PhilHealth members who shall give birth in the Birthing Facility. A reimbursement fund shall be paid by PhilHealth Corporation to birthing facility for the specific services rendered to the mother and child who availed the Package.
- **Nurse** - a licensed nurse who is duly employed as regular and permanent employee of the municipality.
- **Patient** - a pregnant IP or non-IP woman who avails the birthing services.
- **PHILHEALTH** - Philippine Health Insurance Corporation
- **PHILHEALTH Capitation Fund** - is the fund paid by the PHIL HEALTH Corporation to the RHU for specific services it provides for a particular period which is based on a predetermined criteria under the condition that any savings from the agreed amount accrues to the benefit of the RHU.
- **PHILHEALTH member patient** - a patient who is duly registered or enrolled in PHILHEALTH
- **Resident** - a patient that is bonafide resident of the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur
- **RHU** - Rural Health Unit
- **TBAs** - Trained Birth Attendance
- **Volunteer Midwife/Nurse** - a volunteer midwife/nurse without receiving any remuneration.

Section 4. COVERAGE.

The MBF shall serve those who have pre-natal records in the health centers within its territorial jurisdiction of the municipality. Birthing facility may accept non-residence depending on the capability of the staff and the resources of the municipality. In emergency cases, the MBF may accept non-residents of the municipality.

Section 5. SUPERVISION AND CONTROL OF THE BIRTHING FACILITY.

The operation of the Macasing Birthing Facility shall be under the supervision and control of the Rural Health Unit.

Section 6. TIME AND DAY OF OPERATIONS....

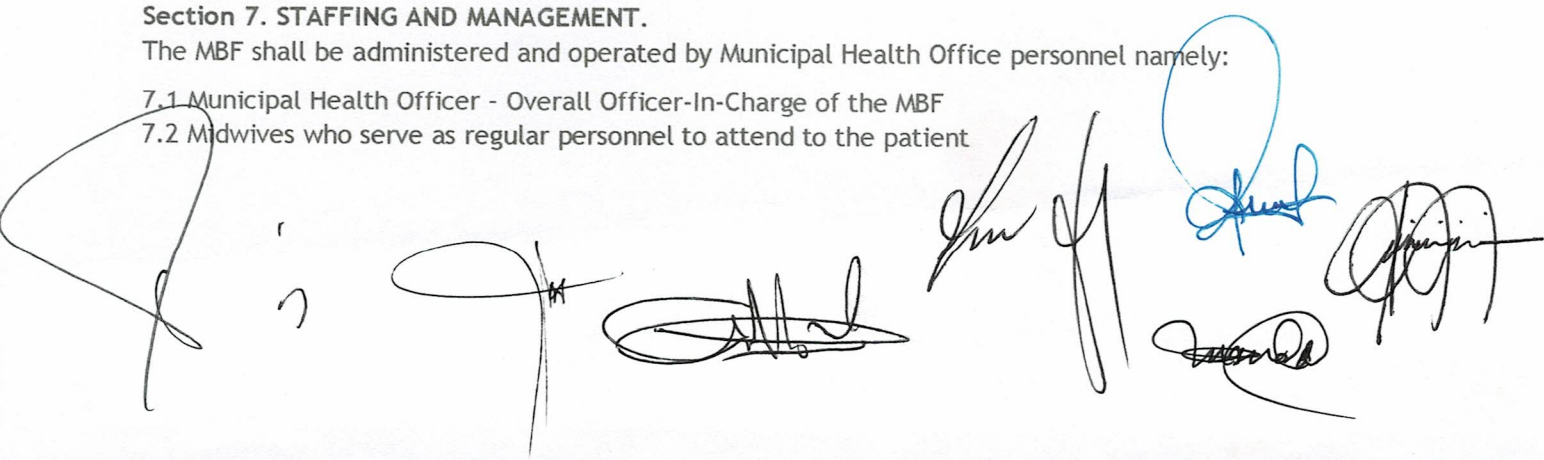
The Birthing Facility shall operate twenty-four (24) hours a day, 7 days a week.

Section 7. STAFFING AND MANAGEMENT.

The MBF shall be administered and operated by Municipal Health Office personnel namely:

7.1 Municipal Health Officer - Overall Officer-In-Charge of the MBF

7.2 Midwives who serve as regular personnel to attend to the patient



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- 7.3 Casual/Job Order Midwife/Nurse or Volunteer Midwife/Nurse who is assisting the regular personnel of MBF
- 7.4 Utility Worker - person responsible for the cleanliness of the entire MBF and other minor tasks to be assigned from time to time by his/her immediate superior
- 7.5 Trained Birth Attendant and Barangay Health Workers - Monitoring and pregnancy Tracking; Referral to birthing facility; Assist the Midwives during birth delivery.

Section 8. OVERTIME.

Availment of overtime of the Macasing Birthing Facility personnel and as corresponding payments shall conform to the existing rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission, Magna Carta of Public Health Workers or RA 7305 and DBM-DOH Joint Circular No. 01 series of 2012 dated Nov. 29, 2012 and Budget Circular No. 10 dated March 29, 1996. (Leave Credits)

Section 9. SERVICE FEE.

PhilHealth member patients aged 21 to 35 years old who are not at risk pregnancy and qualified dependents newborns per PhilHealth guidelines are free from charges. However, non-PhilHealth member patients have to purchase/pay the supplies and medicines used during the labor and delivery.

No fee shall be collected from the patient when the MBF refers her to the Rural Health Unit/BEmONC. A newborn screening fee is collected from non-qualified PhilHealth dependents as imposed by the Newborn Screening Center.

Section 10. DISPOSITION OF PHILHEALTH CAPITATION FUND (PCF).

All funds received from PhilHealth shall be treated as Trust Funds and in compliance to PhilHealth Circular No. 39, s. 2009 it shall be disburse as follows:

- Sixty percent (60%) of the MCP reimbursement fund from PHIC shall be for the facility, supplies, medicines and other services intended for maternal and child care.
- Forty percent (40%) of the MCP reimbursement fund from PHIC shall be divided among the personnel who rendered services at the MBF (Macasing Birthing Facility).

Section 11. CREATION AND ALLOCATION OF FUNDS.

All funds received from PhilHealth as case rate payment shall be accrued to the Trust Fund/Account of the Dumingag Rural Health Unit and shall be disbursed based on the PhilHealth circular and performance commitment.

All funds received other than the MCP funds from PHIC shall be accrued to the Trust Fund of the mBF and shall be allocated and appropriated for:

- 11.1 Procurement of all drugs, medicines and supplies necessary in the operations of MBF.
- 11.2 Necessary equipment for the improvement of MBF services.
- 11.3 Fuel, oil and maintenance cost of the ambulance or Emergency Transport System and generator assigned to MBF
- 11.4 Repairs and maintenance of the MBF facilities and equipments
- 11.5 Honorarium of Trained Birth Attendants and BHWs

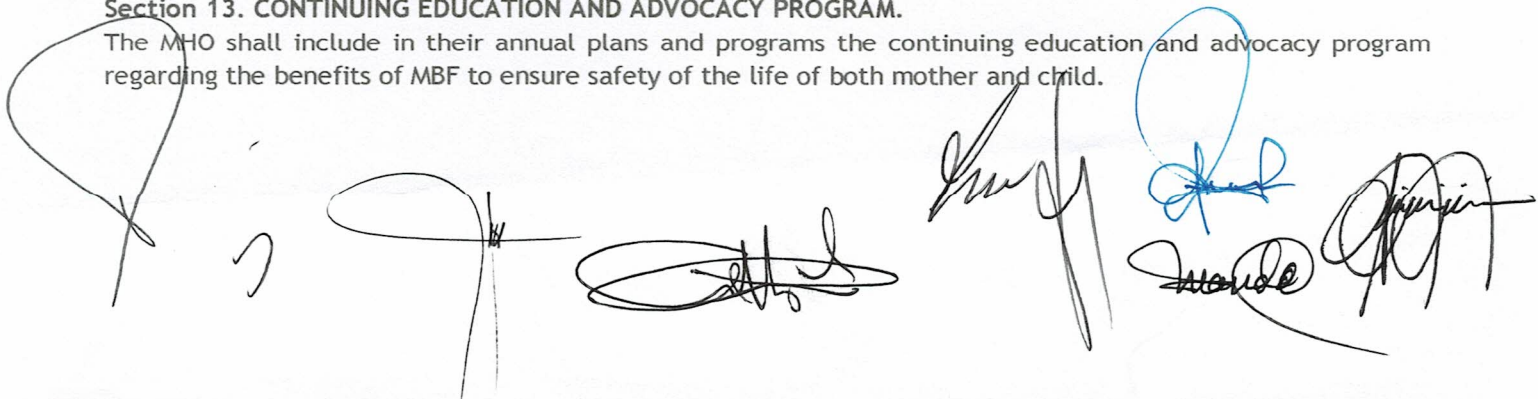
Catchment barangays of BHS Datu Tutukan and Macasing shall pool resources for the MBF.

Section 12. CULTURE-SENSITIVE BIRTH DELIVERY PRACTICE FOR IPs.

The Macasing Birthing Facility shall observe birth delivery practice in accordance to the cultural practices of IPs deem appropriate if requested by an IP patient. If indigenous practice of birth delivery shall be observed duly accompanied and assisted by an IP elder or TBAs who are familiar of such practice. An IP patient has to inform ahead of time the midwives for this option in order to seek support from the elder of TBA.

Section 13. CONTINUING EDUCATION AND ADVOCACY PROGRAM.

The MHO shall include in their annual plans and programs the continuing education and advocacy program regarding the benefits of MBF to ensure safety of the life of both mother and child.

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Section 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this ordinance or any part thereof be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other provisions or any part thereof not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 15. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion.
