Municipal Ordinance No. 21, s. 2015

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE, CREATING THE PLANTILLA POSITION OF MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICER III (SALARY GRADE 18), PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sanggunian Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, in session assemble that:

SECTION 1. Title. This ordinance shall be otherwise known as the "Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO).

SECTION 2. Statutory Basis. Section 443(B)(2) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sanggunian Bayan to create such other facilities as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of the Municipal Government. And Section 12(a)(b), RA 10121, otherwise known as Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, mandates that every Local Government Unit shall establish the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (LDRRMO).

SECTION 3. Declaration of Policy. Pursuant to the provisions of RA No. 10121, it is hereby declared the policy of the Sanggunian Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur to:

- Adopt a disaster risk reduction and management approach that is holistic, comprehensive, integrated, and proactive in lessening the socioeconomic and environmental impacts of disasters including climate change, and promote the involvement and participation of all sectors and all stakeholders concerned;
- Mainstream disaster risk reduction and climate change in development processes such as policy formulation, socioeconomic development planning, budgeting, and governance;
- Mainstream disaster risk reduction into the peace process and conflict resolution approaches in order to minimize loss of lives and damage to property, and ensure that communities in conflict zones can immediately go back to their normal lives during periods of intermittent conflicts; and
- Engage the participation of civil society organizations (CSOs), the private sector and volunteers in the government's disaster risk reduction programs towards complementation of resources and effective delivery of services to the citizenry.

Section 4. Establishing the MDRRMO. There shall be established the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) under the Office of the Municipal Mayor, pursuant to RA No. 10121. The MDRRMO shall be responsible for setting the direction, development, implementation and coordination of disaster risk management programs within the territorial jurisdiction of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur.

Section 5. Creation of MDRRM Officer III. The plantilla position of Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer III is hereby created, with Salary Grade 18, who shall head the MDRRM Office, pursuant to NDRRM-DILG-DBM- CSC-JMC No. 2014-1 dated April 4, 2014. The minimum qualification for this position shall be subject to the qualification standards provided in JMC No. 2014-1 and other pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

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perform the functions stipulated in JMC No. 2014-1, specifically the following:

- a. DRRM Research and Planning;
- b. DRRM Administration and Training; and
- c. DRRM Operations and Warning.

The MDRRM Officer shall likewise perform such other functions and responsibilities that may be authorized by the MDRRM Council.

Section 7. MDRRMO Staff. The MDRRM Officer, as the Head of the MDRRM Office, shall have as his/her staff at least three (3) Municipal DRRM Officer I, SG 11, each to man the Research and Planning, Administration and Training, and Operations and Warning sections of the MDRRM Office, respectively. If the resources of the municipal government suffice, additional plantilla positions may be created pursuant to JMC No. 2014 - 1.

Section 8. Appropriations. The appropriations for the operation of the MDRRM Office, and the salaries, benefits and other emoluments of the MDRRM Officer III and his/her staff shall be provided in the annual and supplemental budgets of the municipality.

Section 9. Transitory Provisions. When appropriations for personal services are insufficient, the Local Chief Executive may augment the staff of the MDRRMO through any or a combination of the following options:

- a. Designation or assignment of personnel of the municipal government to the MDRRMO in concurrent capacities with their existing positions;
- b. Reassignment of personnel to the MDRRMO; and
- c. Transfer of existing vacant positions from other office to the MDRRMO. Accordingly, such vacant positions shall be abolished and positions appropriate to the MDRRMO shall be created.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. Ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, or part or parts thereof, insofar as inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 11. Separability Clause. The declaration, unconstitutionality or invalidity of any provision of this Ordinance shall not affect other provisions not affected thereby.

Section 12. Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and the posting thereof in bulletin boards at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two other conspicuous and publicly accessible places within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality.

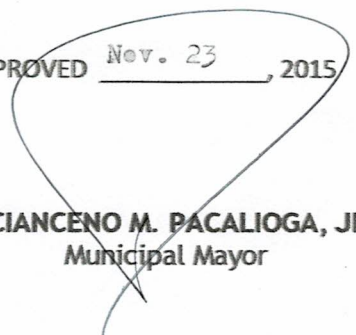
