Municipal Ordinance No. 23, s. 2019

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING CAPABILITY DEVELOPMENT (CAPDEV) TRAINING COURSE AT DUMINGAG INSTITUTE OF SUSTAINABLE ORGANIC AGRICULTURE (DISOA) AND SETTING REGISTRATION FEES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as the "Capability Development Training Course Registration Fees in the Municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur."

Section 2. BACKGROUND.

Pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991, Section 16, under the General Welfare Clause that "... local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants."

The Municipality of Dumingag is known as one of the lead movers of Organic Agriculture in the Philippines and the world. Since 2007, the program of government of Dumingag, the Genuine People's Agenda or GPA (Municipal Ordinance No. 1, s. 2017) addresses the needs, issues and concerns of every Dumingagnons. Agenda stated are to "Adopt a Fundamental Method of Learning and Capability Building" and to "Strengthen the Sustainable Organic Farming System" and that each will be taking a part of the governance and developmental processes that implies people empowerment especially the sectoral organizations formed. It also seeks to liberate the people from poverty, sickness and hunger.

Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture (DISOA) is a school that trains farmers on sustainable organic farming system and leadership, and one of the main thrusts is to address hunger through Sustainable Organic Agriculture. To promote Sustainable Organic Agriculture nationwide, many agencies, cities and other neighboring municipalities express interests in learning the program and the best practices in Dumingag.

Section 3. OBJECTIVES.

Capability Development Training Courses aims to:

- Promote Sustainable Organic Agriculture nationwide;
- Develop organizations that results to an accountable and responsible society;
- Raise public awareness with regards on the key concepts of GPA, leadership skills and discipline to other Municipalities;
- Facilitate the development of new good ideas;
- Develop organizations that will ensure the continuity and sustainability of the governance and development that results to an accountable and responsible society;
- Identify concerns on matters relating to existing problems in the marketplace and others; and
- Attract potential business investors.

Section 4. REGISTRATION FEES.

The following are the rates for Special Training and General Training Courses per participants:

General Training

Meals and Snacks	P650.00/ day x 3 days
Room Accommodation	P100.00/ night x 2 nights
3-Days Training - P1, 950.00 (Meals and Snacks) + P200.00 (Room Accommodation) + P850.00 (one-time payment) = P3,000.00	

Special Training	
Training Fee (Inclusion: Laboratory Materials, Training Kit and Instructor's Fee)	P2,000.00 (One-Time Payment)
Meals and Snacks	P650.00/ day
Room Accommodation	P100.00/ night
Breakdown: 7-Days Training - P4, 550.00 (Meals and Snacks: P650.00 x 7 days) + P600.00 (Room Accommodation: P100.00 x 6 nights) + P2,000.00 (one-time payment) = P7, 150.00 15-Days Training - P9, 750.00 (Meals and Snacks: P650.00 x 15 days) + P1,400.00 (Room Accommodation: P100.00 x 14 nights) + P2,000.00 (one-time payment) = P13, 150.00 30-Days Training - P19,500.00 (Meals and Snacks: P650.00 x 30 days) + P2,900.00 (Room Accommodation: P100.00 x 29 nights) + P2,000.00 (one-time payment) = P24,400.00	

Section 5. COURSE OUTLINE.

- General Trainings** includes but not limited to Genuine People's Agenda (GPA) Training, Leadership and Discipline, Sustainable Organic Agriculture, Integrative Medicine, Organic Cookery, Organic Feeds Formulation and Mushroom Production.
- Special Trainings** includes Genuine People's Agenda, Leadership and Discipline, Sustainable Organic Agriculture, Integrative Medicine, Organic Cookery, Organic Feeds Formulation, and community organizing.

Section 6. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES.

Agencies, cities and other municipalities that express interests in learning the program and best practices of Dumingag shall pay the Registration Fee in full amount either 3-Days, 7-Days, 15-Days, and 30-Days to the Municipal Treasurer's Office (MTO), guided that Registration Fees are non-refundable.

Capacity development training courses shall be paid to the account of Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture (DISOA) Fund. In a case where:

1. LGU Dumingag initiate the training course - there shall only be a payment of the usage of session hall amounting five hundred (P500.00) pesos per day and one hundred pesos (P100) per participant per night for the room accommodation; and
2. Business permit renewal and/ or for newly started business - the registration fee amounting six hundred fifty pesos (P650.00) for the 3-Day Course shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer's Office (*as per Municipal Ordinance No. 2, s. 2019 Article B, Section 3B.08*), guided that the owner shall be responsible attending the training.

There shall be a rate for meals amounting One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per person and snacks amounting Fifty Pesos (P50.00) per person for food catering services.

Section 7. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the Office of the Municipal Mayor through Municipal Treasurer's Office in coordination with Dumingag Institute of Sustainable Organic Agriculture (DISOA) and shall formulate additional guidelines for proper implementation of this ordinance.

Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any portion of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other portions thereof not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 9. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Any portion of an ordinance order or memorandum of local effect inconsistent with the provision/s of this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately
