Municipal Ordinance No. 3, s. 2015

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CLIMATE RESILIENCY ORGANIC FIELD SCHOOL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, AND PROVIDING MECHANICS FOR IMPLEMENTATION THEREFORE.

Section I. TITLE

An Ordinance Establishing A climate Resiliency Organic Field School in the Municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, and Providing Mechanics for Implementation Therefore.

Section II. DECLARATION OF POLICY

It is the policy of the municipality to address common problems of the community in the field of agriculture, in the challenge of producing organic foods despite of the changing climate, thus this learning field school need to be established.

Section III. PURPOSE

1. Enhance farmers knowledge on climate variability and ability to anticipate extreme climate events and modify farming decisions.
2. Assist farmers in interpreting climate information from PAG-ASA
3. Assist farmers in observing climate observing climate related issues to support farming practices (land preparation, pest management)
4. Provide the forecast information generation in the community with farmer's experiences to assess relevance of information and need to redesign/refine climate information.

Section IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS

Some words are defined to:

1. **Climate Resiliency Organic Field School** - is a learning school institutionalized by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to be used as an early warning device and tool in educating our farmers in producing foods despite of calamities and the changing climate through keen observation and interpretation of present climate condition. This is also the right and proper venue of the farmers in enhancing knowledge on climate variability and ability to anticipate extreme events and modify farming decisions.

Section V. MECHANICS FOR IMPLEMENTATION.

There shall be mechanics crafted for proper and efficient implementation of this ordinance.

1. There shall be created/established a Climate Resiliency Organic Field School (CROFS) in the municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, wherein the field itself is the learning school and the farmers are the students
2. The Climate Resiliency Organic Field School (CROFS) shall be governed by the Local Government Unit of Dumingag, this municipality, and shall be supervised and managed by the Municipal Organic Agriculture and Dumingag Peoples Climate Information Personnels.

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3. The Climate Resiliency Organic Field School Class shall be conducted on the field on every cropping season which starts from early six (6) O'clock in the morning and usually end at early noon.
4. Materials used during the conduct of the study shall be provided by the Local Government Unit in the Fifty-Fifty (50%-50%) percent counterparting scheme.
5. Any support from Non-Governmental Organizations, (NGO's) Governmental Organizations (GO's) National Government Agencies (NGA's) and Peoples Organizations (PO's) are very much welcomed, provided proper coordination with the Municipal Mayor/Administrator shall be properly done.
6. No fees shall be collected to the interesting resident farmer students, (Residing Dumingag Municipality).
7. Barangay Officials are required to encourage their farmers in their respective barangays to enroll and study in the Climate Resiliency Organic Field School when it is conducted in their own barangay.

Section VI. BUDGETARY APPROPRIATION.

In order to sustain the operation of the school, it shall be institutionalized as an integral part of the existing program and priorities of the Local Government Unit of Dumingag and shall be appropriated an amount sufficient for its operation.

Section VII. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY.

The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the office of the Dumingag Peoples Climate Information Center and the Municipal Organic Agriculture shall formulate an implementing rules and regulation and task to implement this ordinance.

Section VIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

Any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

Section IX. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Any resolution or ordinance inconsistent hereof is hereby modified, repealed or superseded accordingly.

Section X. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.

This ordinance shall take effect after review and approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after three (3) weeks from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion and further, announcement in the local cable TV, informing the constituents of the provision and date of effectivity thereof.

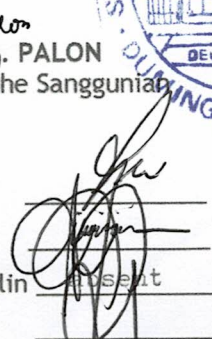

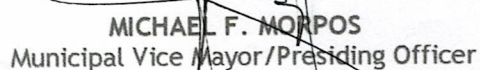

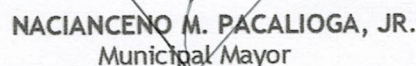
