Municipal Ordinance No. 7, s. 2017

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD ON ANTI-ILLEGAL DRUG PROGRAMS UNDER RA 9165 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be known as the, “Administrative Board on Anti-Illegal Drug Programs.”

SECTION 2. BACKGROUND.

As mandated by the Constitution, the government shall promote the quality of life of the people and among other equally significant concerns. Thus, the increasing use of illegal drugs has significantly contributed to the incidence of heinous crimes.

Under Article VII of RA 9165, section 51 mandated the participation of Local Government Unit in addressing the drug problem, giving priority to preventive or educational programs and the treatment and rehabilitation of drug dependents.

Therefore, this Municipality fully supports the creation of Administrative Board to hear complaints regarding the public nuisances and to the promotion of the General Welfare, Peace and Order under Section 16 of RA 7160.

Section 3. CREATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD (AB) AND ITS FUNCTIONS.

The Administrative Board shall be created and organized whose composition shall be the following:

3.1 Functions of AB:

- a. Hears drug-related complaints and coordinates with concerned agencies in resolving drug-related complaints;
- b. Develops comprehensive, integrated, unified and balanced drug abuse prevention program and control strategies;
- c. Ensures full compliance, participation and support to the provisions of RA 9165 and oversee the operations and implementations of the council;
- d. Ensure that the Anti-Drug Abuse Council at all levels perform their functions and responsibilities as embodied in Department Issuances; and
- e. Ensures a sustainable anti-drug abuse program in matters relating to rehabilitation or treatment program of drug dependents.

SECTION 4. CREATION OF ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (ADAC) AND ITS FUNCTIONS.

The Anti-Drug Abuse Council shall be created and organized whose composition shall be the following:

4.1 Functions of ADAC: The Council shall be the implementing arm of the Administrative Board and shall be responsible to:

- a. Implement the policy and programs of the Administrative Board;
- b. Serve as a focal point through which various organizations and individuals work together cooperatively in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs on drug abuse prevention;
- c. Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services and programs and those which might be developed in the immediate futures;
- d. Provide mechanism to obtain funds, volunteers, facilities and technical expertise; and
- e. Perform other related responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES.

- a. The Administrative Board shall meet once a month or as often as necessary at the discretion of the Chairperson or at the call of a majority of the members of the Board.
- b. The Anti-Drug Abuse Council shall meet once a month or as often as necessary at the discretion of the Chairperson or at the call of a majority of the members of the council.

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.

The provisions of this ordinance shall be headed by the Municipal Mayor.

Section 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any portion of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional, other portions thereof not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Any portion inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE.

This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date, a copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM station and further published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of the effectivity thereof.

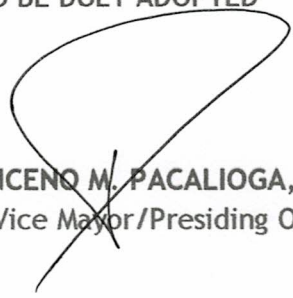

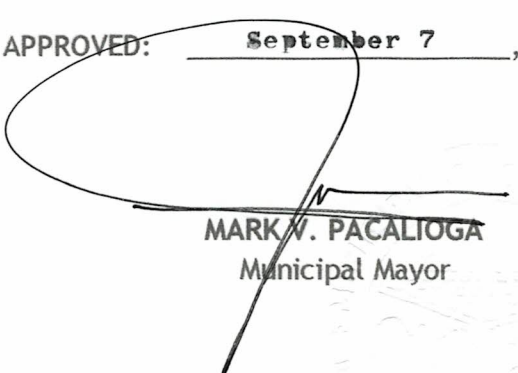
