Ordinance No. 13, s. 2014

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BARANGAY CAPTAINS IN FORTY-FOUR BARANGAYS TO ESTABLISH AND CONSTRUCT A MAKESHIFT SLAUGHTERHOUSE IN THEIR RESPECTIVE BARANGAY, ALL OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

Section I. TITLE.

This ordinance shall be called "An Ordinance Requiring All Barangay Captains In Forty-Four Barangays To Establish And Construct A Makeshift Slaughterhouse In Their Respective Barangay In This Municipality."

Section II. PURPOSE/ SCOPE:

This ordinance shall apply to all forty-four barangay in this municipality for the following purposes:

1. To give convenience to the people in the barangay in slaughtering their animals for food consumption in times of fiestas, Christmas and new years, birthdays, anniversaries and other special occasions.
2. To ensure that meat they eat is good and fit for human consumption.
3. To avoid/minimize the spread of communicable diseases of animals to man
4. To account the number of slaughtered animals to be reported monthly to the National Meat Inspection Commission (NMIC).
5. To add income for the barangay.
6. To monitor the possible wide spreading of animal diseases.

Section III. DEFINITION OF TERMS:

1. **Makeshift slaughterhouse** - temporary slaughterhouse where slaughtered of animals will take place
2. **Good meat** - refers to meat fit for human consumption; disease-free meat
3. **Hot Meat** - pungent with sharp and bitter smell and with unusual color; not fit for human consumption
4. **Licensed butcher** - a skilled, trained or experience butcher certified by the LGU Dumingag who shall be authorized to slaughter animals.

Section IV. MECHANICS FOR IMPLEMENTATION:

The makeshift slaughterhouse shall be:

a. Construction of Makeshift Slaughterhouse

Made of indigenous light materials not less than 20 square meters located at strategic place where road and water is available with equipments and facilities that will be used in slaughtering such as but not limited to:

- enough size of vat or kettle,
- cleaning tables
- knives
- weighing scale
- water tubs

This should be provided with drainage canal, compost pit for waste disposal.

Only licensed butcher is authorized to slaughter. Imposition of penalty shall be imposed to unauthorized slaughtering outside premises of slaughterhouse.

b. Meat Inspector

There shall be a mobile/meat inspector the LGU provides for every occasion scheduled by the barangay captains to ensure that meat is good and fit for human consumption. The Barangay Captain or his representative shall formally and officially request to the Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Municipal Treasurer inviting the Meat Inspector at least three (3) days prior to the slaughtering of animals in the barangay makeshift slaughterhouse.

c. Officer-In-Charge

There shall be an officer-in-charge designated by the Barangay Captain during the operation of the makeshift slaughterhouse. He/she should be a barangay official, appointed or elected to monitor and ensure the availability of the service facilities used during the operation such as but not limited to sufficient water supply, light to be used during night time or dark hours, and cleaning the drainage canal from time to time. Ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and control measures be applied before, during and after the slaughter operation.

d. Butchers

Each barangay is encouraged to have a resident licensed butcher. During special occasions, the barangay may request licensed butchers in the neighboring barangay to perform the job.

License will be secured after the applicant will undergo proper training at the municipal slaughterhouse. The Punong Barangay will issue the license to slaughter based on the recommendation of the meat inspector.

Section V. REQUIRING PROVISIONS:

1. No individual/household is allowed to slaughter animal outside the makeshift slaughterhouse.
2. Licensed butcher is not allowed to slaughter animal outside makeshift slaughterhouse.
3. Distant purok or sitio may be allowed to construct makeshift slaughterhouse. Provided, there shall be a barangay makeshift slaughterhouse and approval from the Barangay Council.
4. Meat Inspector is authorized only to inspect good or hot slaughtered meat at the barangay makeshift slaughterhouse.
5. Unauthorized/unlicensed butcher is not allowed to slaughter animals.
6. Meat Inspector is required to dispose or burn the hot meat with the presence of the owner or other witness.

Section VI. TRANSITORY PROVISION:

There shall be a transition period of six (6) months from the date of the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan wherein the Barangays are allowed to slaughter animals for food consumption without makeshift slaughterhouse.

Section VII. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY:

The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the Municipal Treasurer's Office is mandated to formulate rules and regulations for strict implementation of this ordinance.

Section VIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE:

Any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

Section IX. REPEALING CLAUSE.

Any resolution or ordinance inconsistent hereof is hereby modified, repealed or superseded accordingly.

Section X. EFFECTIVITY.
