Ordinance No. 22, s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SELLING OF FISH OUTSIDE THE PUBLIC MARKET.

WHEREAS, observations have shown that for years now fish vendors sell their fish (dried and fresh) in their homes and along the roads within the poblacion and in the declared urban land use areas which become a deterrent in terms of the health of the people and business of fish vendors in the market;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be called, " AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SELLING OF FISH OUTSIDE THE PUBLIC MARKET."

Section 2. PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF APPLICATION. This ordinance is enacted to curb the practice of fish vendors in selling fish in places outside the public market. It is enacted to keep the areas from any health hazard due to the presence of waste thrown/spread around the stalls which invite flies for their breeding areas which in turn spread diseases and to keep the consumers from buying fish from outsiders which goods are not subjected for inspection by the market health and sanitary inspector. It is also enacted to prevent loss of revenue due to the dwindling of buyers from public market fish vendors who are sources of taxes for the coffer of the municipality.

Section 3. REGULATORY PROVISIONS.

3.1. No fish vendor is allowed to sell fish outside the public market.

3.2. The following are the areas ~~within~~ which selling of fish is banned:

3.2.1. Upper Landing portion located at junction barangay road leading to Guitran River.

3.2.2. Fifty (50) meters away from NIA compound corners Lower Landing barangay and provincial road.

3.2.3. Control line intersecting provincial roads (formerly Buagas residence Mauswagon)

3.2.4. Intersection NIA road, Basak and Maleo barangay roads

3.2.5. Intersection Maralag - Libertad barangay roads

3.2.6. ¹Corners Caridad barangay road and pathway/trail leading to SDA chapel

3.2.7. Along Guitran River banks

Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance, order, memorandum which may be in conflict with or inconsistent to this ordinance is hereby repealed or modified.

Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If a part or parts of this ordinance are considered unconstitutional, the rest of the provisions thereof shall be in full force and effect.

Section 6. PENAL PROVISION. Any person found violating this ordinance shall suffer the following penalty:

6.1. First Offense - stern warning

6.2. Second Offense - confiscation of goods (fish)

6.3. Third and subsequent offenses - confiscation of goods (fish) and cancellation of business license.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the Local Cable TV and FM station and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.

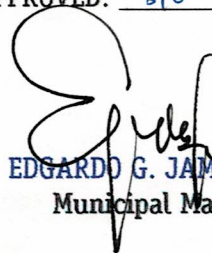
