Ordinance No. 26, s. 2002

A SUPPLEMENTARY ORDINANCE PROMOTING THE PLAYING OF BILLIARD BY MINORS AND  
STUDENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG.

WHEREAS, billiard was once considered a game of chance and minors and students were either totally or partially prohibited to engage in playing it;

WHEREAS, in the recent years when billiard became one of the recognized world sports and when Filipinos became renowned players, it became apparent that it should be part of other sports activities that our children and youth have to participate in;

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. The title of this ordinance shall be, "A Supplementary Ordinance Promoting the Playing of Billiard By Minors and Students in the Municipality of Dumingag."

Section 2. PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF APPLICATION. This ordinance is enacted to supplement Municipal Ordinance No. 20, s. 1996 ( An Ordinance Regulating Mahjong and Billiard Games : Total Prohibition for Minors and Partial Prohibition for Students and Imposing Penalties for Violation Thereof) and Ordinance No. 24, s. 2001 ( An Ordinance Prohibiting the Participation, Operation or Playing of Games of Chance Such as, But Not Limited to Mahjong, Masiao, Jueting, Cara y Cruz, and Bridge (Playing Cards) of Minors. It is enacted to ~~prohibit~~ promote the participation or playing of it by minors and students.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms shall be defined according to their use in this ordinance:

- 3.1. Game of Chance. It is a game wherein players and/or onlookers/spectators bet with the aim in view of winning
- 3.2. Mahjong. A game of Chinese origin played with 144 little tiles
- 3.3. Billiard. Any of several games played on a rectangular table by driving ball against each other or into pocket with a cue.



- 4.1. Billiard stations may be operated in any place legally suitable for its operation in the municipality provided, however, that there is proper permits issued to the owner/operator by the agencies/offices concerned.
- 4.2. Minors may be allowed to play the game by paying the required rental or table charge for each play
- 4.3. Minors and students are allowed to play billiard in billiard stations holidays and weekends and only up to curfew hours, for minors
- 4.4. Minors and students are prohibited to make or turn billiard into a game of chance by engaging in betting
- 4.5. Owners or operators are hereby mandated to disallow minors and students from playing during ordinary or school days and from betting
- 4.6. School should include billiard as one of the sports/athletic activities and must be part of the competitive events in the local and higher sports competitions.
- 4.7. ~~At least~~<sup>B</sup> billiard sports tournament shall be held regularly in this municipality in order to promote it.

Section 5. ENFORCEMENT AGENCY. The Office of the Municipal Mayor through the PNP in charge of the Women's and Children's Desk and the Brgy. Officials are the enforces of this ordinance.

#### Section 6. PENAL PROVISIONS.

##### 6.1. Penalty For Minors and Students Violating the Ordinance.

6.1.1. First Offense - Stern warning/reprimand

6.1.2. Second and Subsequent offenses - confrontation among teacher adviser, parent/s and the PNP in charge of the Women and Children's Desk.

##### 6.2. Owners/Operators caught tolerating minors/students to play during ordinary/school days or during curfew hours for minors shall be meted any of the following penalties:

6.2.1. First offense - P200.00

6.2.2. Second offense - P500.00

6.2.3. Third and subsequent offenses - Cancellation of business permit and closure of the establishment/business.

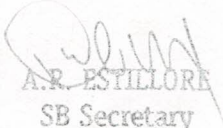
Section 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any resolution, ordinance, order or memorandum or portion thereof of local application inconsistent hereof is hereby repealed, modified and superseded accordingly.

Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any portion of this ordinance may be declared unconstitutional or invalid the remaining provisions thereof not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.

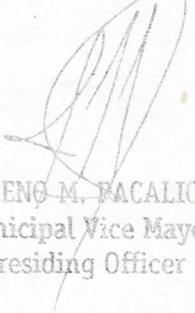
Section 9. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM stations and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.

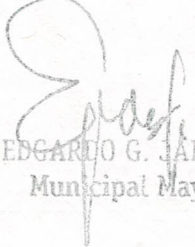
