Ordinance No. 3, s. 2001

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY ESPECIALLY ESTABLISHMENTS ENGAGED IN FOOD RELATED BUSINESSES TO PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE RESTROOM FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE CONSUMING PUBLIC

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled that:

Section 1. *TITLE* – This ordinance shall be called “An Ordinance Requiring All Commercial Establishments in the Municipality Especially Establishments Engaged in Food Related Businesses to Provide at least one Restroom for the Convenience of the Consuming Public.”

Section 2. *DEFINITION OF TERMS* – For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- A. Restroom – a room in a public building, equipped with toilets, washbowls, etc.
- B. Municipal Health Officer – Local Health Officer.
- C. Plumbing Engineer – in charge of the preparation of plans and specifications and design of any ongoing structure to be constructed and the direct supervisor of the Master Plumber doing plumbing and sanitary works.
- D. Master Plumber – in charge in the construction/installation of plumbing works and sanitation works with the direct supervision of the Plumbing Engineer based on the approved plans and specifications.
- E. Sanitary Inspector – a government personnel employed by the municipal government, who enforces sanitary rules, laws and regulations and implements environmental sanitation activities under the supervision of the municipal health officer.
- F. Establishment – a thing established, as a business.

Section 3. **REGULATORY PROVISIONS** – There shall be adopted a regulatory provisions for purposes of this ordinance.

1. All commercial establishments within the municipality are required to provide at least one restroom for the convenience of the consuming public, to wit:
 - a. Food related businesses such as restaurants, carenderias, canteen, refreshments, snack centers, cafes, cafeterias, food caterers, and other similar businesses.
 - b. Hotels, motels, apartments, lodging and boarding houses, tenements, etc.
 - c. Other establishments.
2. As the case may be, other establishments not specified is also required to comply the provisions of this ordinance and this will be determined by the MHO upon recommendation of the Sanitary Inspector.
3. All new house/building to be constructed for commercial purposes which aims categorically covers the scope of this ordinance shall comply with the plans and specifications approved by the MHO and the Plumbing Engineer or a Master Plumber prior to its construction.
4. All existing business establishments are mandated by this ordinance to secure Sanitary Permit.
5. Local Government of Dumingag shall provide a public restroom in the commercial centers within government owned lots and buildings, as mandated for in this ordinance.
6. The Sanitary Inspector shall recommend to the MHO for approval or disapproval of the Sanitary Permit issuance to resisting and/or closure of any establishment not obedient to the provision of this ordinance.

Section 4. **PENAL PROVISIONS** – Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be punished by an imprisonment of not less than fifteen (15) days but not more than one (1) month or a fine not to exceed P1,000.00 or both upon the discretion of the court.

Section 5. **IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS** – The Municipal Mayor shall formulate an implementing guidelines for proper implementation of this ordinance. The Municipal Health Office is the lead agency to see to it that this ordinance is properly implemented.

Section 6. **EFFECTIVITY** – This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval.
