Ordinance No. 4, s. 2002

ORDINANCE PENALIZING ANY ACTS OF VANDALISM IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG.

WHEREAS, continuing acts of vandalism have been observed in the marred and scarred trees, road signs, billboards, walls, fence, public and private building and other public/private properties in the municipality of Dumingag;

WHEREAS, a legal intervention is in order to curb these malpractices;

THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance is entitled, "Anti-Vandalism Law of Dumingag."

Section 2. PURPOSE. This ordinance is enacted for the prevention, control and abatement of vandalism and related acts in order to promote and enhance environment (ecological balance and beautification).

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. Each of the terms used in this ordinance shall mean and be understood in accordance with the following concepts and definitions:

31. *Abatement*. Decrease

32. *Vandalism*. Willful or malicious destruction or defacement of public or private property.

Section 4. REGULATORY PROVISIONS

4.1 Any person is prohibited to deliberate/willfully/maliciously destroy or deface or mar or scar trees, road sign, billboards, wall, fence, public and private properties within the municipality of Dumingag by means of writing, painting or spraying that result to disfigured, unattractive and ugly environment which is an eyesore to the onlookers and passersby.

4.2 No person is allowed to cause other persons or his/her domestic animals to destroy/deface/mar/scar properties mentioned in paragraph 1 Section 4 of this ordinance.

Section 5. PENAL PROVISION

5.1 Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be punish by a fine of not less than P500.00 or an imprisonment not exceeding one (1) month or both at the discretion of the court.

Section 6. ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES. The PNP through its Municipal Police Station, Barangay Officials, Paramilitary personnel in the barangay are hereby mandated to enforce this ordinance.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM station and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of the effectivity thereof.
