Ordinance No. 4, s. 2009

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR, TO CONDUCT FLAG RAISING CEREMONY EVERY WEEK AND PROVIDING FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be called "An Ordinance Requiring All Officials and Employees of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of the Municipality of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, to Conduct Flag Raising Ceremony Every Week and Providing for its Implementation.

Section 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. In accordance with Republic Act No. 8491, it is the policy of the municipality that reverence and respect shall at all times be accorded the flag, the anthem and other national symbols which embody the national ideas and traditions and which express the principles of sovereignty and national solidarity.

Section 3. DESIGN OF THE PHILIPPINE FLAG. The flag of the Philippine shall be blue, white and red with an eight-rayed golden-yellow and three five-pointed stars, as consecrated and honored by the people.

Section 4. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES.

1. All LGU officials and employees shall henceforth observe the flag-raising ceremony every Monday morning at 8:00 in the morning. All officials and employees whether regular or casual/contractual shall be required to attend the ceremony.
2. The ceremony shall be simple and dignified and shall include the playing or singing of the national anthem in its original Filipino lyrics and march tempo. Following shall be the recitation of the pledge of allegiance.
3. While singing the national anthem, all officials and employees shall execute and salute by placing their right palm over their left chest. The pledge of allegiance to the Philippine flag shall be recited while standing with right hand with palm open raised shoulder high.
4. The Personnel Officer shall assign an entity/office to sponsor every flag-raising ceremony which shall prepare the program.

5. When a holiday falls on Monday, the immediate following working day shall the flag-raising ceremony be conducted.
6. The personnel office shall ensure that this mandate shall strictly be complied with.

Section 5. SANCTION. Failure or refusal to observe the provision of this ordinance shall be a ground for administrative discipline.

Section 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision of this ordinance or part thereof declared unconstitutional or unlawful, the other parts not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any part of provisions of this ordinance in conflict with or contrary to the existing ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 8. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after 15 days a copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board in the municipal hall and two other conspicuous places.
