Ordinance No. 4, s. 2010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 4, S. 1997 (AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SMOKING INSIDE GOVERNMENT OFFICES, SCHOOLS, HOSPITALS/CLINICS AND PUBLIC CONVEYANCES, BY PROVIDING AND DESIGNATING SMOKING AREAS AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF) THEREBY MODIFYING THE PENALTIES PROVIDED THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur, in session assembled that:

Section 1. PURPOSE. In order to give more teeth to the Anti-Smoking Ordinance and to serve as a further warning and induce the people within the municipality not to smoke, it is imperative that the penalties provided for shall be amended thereby providing for stricter and heavier penalties.

Section 2. Section 4 of the Municipal Ordinance No. 4, s. 1997 is hereby amended by changing it to section 4 and to read as follows:

Section 4. PENAL PROVISIONS. Any persons found guilty of violating any section of this ordinance shall be fined to Five Hundred (P500.00) Pesos for his/her first offense and One Thousand (P1,000.00) Pesos for second offense or suffer an imprisonment of not less than five (5) days but not more than ten (10) days or both at the discretion of the court.

Any person found guilty of violating the Anti-Smoking Ordinance for the third time or more shall be fined of Two Thousand (P2,000.00) Pesos and suffer an imprisonment of not less than ten (10) days.

Section 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any existing resolutions, ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby modified, repealed or superseded accordingly.

Section 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision or part of this ordinance may be declared invalid or unconstitutional, other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy thereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Hall and at least two (2) conspicuous places in the Poblacion and its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the province.
