Ordinance No. 6, s. 2002

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF ALL SIDESTREETS OF POBLACION, DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AS AREAS FOR REPAIR, MAINTENANCE, CAR WASHING, VULCANIZING AND PARKING AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF"

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance is entitled, "An Ordinance Prohibiting the Use of All Sidestreets of Poblacion Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur as Areas for Repair, Maintenance, Car Washing, Vulcanizing and Parking and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof"

Section 2. AUTHORITY SCOPE AND PURPOSE. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to LTFRB Memorandum circular No. 93-011 with the purpose of minimizing, if not totally eradicating, road obstructions and accidents and at the same time, maintaining good traffic flow of vehicles in the poblacion of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- 3.1 *Car washing.* The act or process of cleaning vehicles with water
- 3.2 *Maintenance.* It is the upkeep of vehicles
- 3.3 *Repair.* It is the process of rebuilding renewing or restoring partially damaged vehicle
- 3.4 *Parking.* Bringing to a stop a vehicle on the sidestreet and remains inactive in that place or close thereto for an appreciable period of time. A motor vehicle which properly stops merely to discharge a passenger or to take in a waiting passenger, or to load or unload a small quantity of freight with reasonable dispatch shall not, in the context of this ordinance, be considered as "parked" if the motor vehicle again moves away without delay.
- 3.5 *Sidestreet.* It refers to the public roadway, thoroughfare boulevard, driveway and avenue but shall not include roadway upon grounds owned by private persons, colleges, universities or other similar institutions.

Section 4. REGULATORY PROVISIONS

- 4.1 It is required of all operators/owners to put up/use a garage for their vehicles instead of public places or sidestreets in parking their vehicles.
- 4.2 Motor vehicle operators or owners and machine or Vulcanizing Shop Operators and car wash owners are prohibited to use the sidestreets as areas for repair or maintenance work, car washing and other machine and Vulcanizing shop-related activities.

Section 5. PENAL PROVISION. Any operator/owner of any kind of Vehicles and Machine Shop or Vulcanizing Shop Operators found violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be meted the following penalties:

- 1st offense - stern warning
2nd offense - P300.00
3rd offense - P500.00 or imprisonment of not more than 10 days but not less than 5 days, or both at the discretion of the court.

Section 6. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY. The Municipal Police Station through its traffic officers shall strictly enforce this ordinance at all prescribed times.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY AND PUBLICATION CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two (2) other conspicuous places in the Poblacion, announcement in the local cable TV and FM station and further, published in a local newspaper of general circulation once a week for three consecutive weeks, informing the constituents of the provisions and date of effectivity thereof.

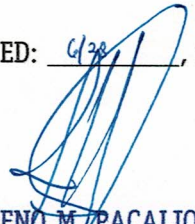
