Ordinance No. 6, s. 2008

AN ORDINANCE CREATING DUMINGAG TECHNOLOGICAL TRAINING SCHOOL (DTTS), DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR AND PROVIDING MECHANICS FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND FUNDS FOR ITS OPERATION THEREFORE.

WHEREAS, Section 447(a)5(x) of Republic Act 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sangguniang Bayan is mandated, subject to the availability of funds and to the existing laws, rules and regulations, to establish and provide for the operation of Vocational Technical Schools with the approval from the Department of Education and to fix and collect reasonable fees and other school charges on said institution, subject to existing laws on tuition fees;

WHEREAS, this institution would cater to the lot of high school graduates, out of school youth and other adults in this municipality and other neighboring municipalities as well, to develop their technical knowledge and skills for personal advantage in the future;

WHEREAS, to implement the functions and responsibilities of Local Government Unit to attain such vision in maximizing and massive education campaign to liberate people from illiteracy, the creation and establishment of schools was found necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan Members of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Ordinance Creating Dumingag Technological Training School (DTTS), Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur and Providing Mechanics for Implementation and Funds for its Operation Therefore.

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES. This Ordinance is enacted for the following objectives.

- To promote and uplift high level of education
- To liberate people from illiteracy
- To promote additional employment
- To alleviate people from poverty through education

SECTION 3. MECHANICS OF IMPLEMENTATION.

- There shall be an independently owned and operated school by this LGU, the "Dumingag Technological Training School", Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur.

- b. The school shall be managed and supervised by the Municipal Economic Development Office(MEDO)
- c. All employees and instructors are LGU - hired
- d. There will be a separate bank account for the school which shall be maintained by the Municipal Treasurer and the Municipal Mayor
- e. The Administrator and Trainers of DTTS will serve as a planning, implementing and monitoring body subject to the legal mandates of the Local Government Unit
- f. All equipment, facilities, buildings established are owned by the LGU.

SECTION 4. BUDGETARY AND FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS. All salaries and wages of the items created under this ordinance as well as its maintenance, operations, and cost shall be covered with appropriations to be included in the annual regular budget to be determined by the concerned personnel designated by the Chief Executive for the purpose.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision of this ordinance or parts thereof declared unconstitutional or unlawful, the other parts not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

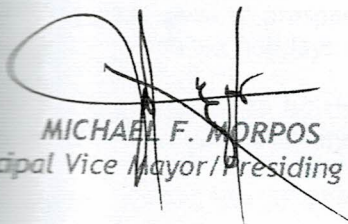
SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any parts or provisions of this ordinance in conflict with or contrary to the existing ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after fifteen (15) days from the date copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the municipal hall and at least two other conspicuous places in the Poblacion.

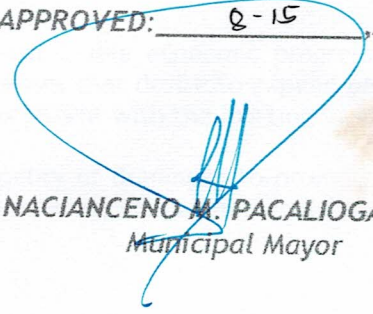
