Ordinance No. 8, s. 2009

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE MUNICIPAL INDIGENOUS PEOPLES AFFAIRS OFFICE AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR ITS OPERATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Dumingag, Zamboanga del Sur in session assembled that:

Section 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is the policy of the municipality to recognize and promote the rights of the indigenous cultural communities, protect the right to preserve and develop their cultures, traditions and institutions, protect their rights to ancestral domain to ensure their economic, social and cultural well-being and take measures to protect their rights and guarantee respect for their cultural integrity and ensure that IP members benefit on an equal footing from the rights and opportunities which laws and regulations grant to other members of the population.

Section 3. CREATION. There is hereby created the Municipal Indigenous Peoples Affairs Office referred to as MIPAO.

Section 4. COMPOSITION OF FUND. The Municipal Indigenous Peoples Affairs Office shall be composed and manned by the following:

- 4.1. One (1) Municipal Indigenous Peoples Affairs Officer with the salary grade twenty-four (24)
- 4.2. One (1) Administrative Assistant I with salary grade eight (8)
- 4.3. One (1) Liaison Assistant I with salary grade eight (8)
- 4.4. One (1) Administrative Services Aide with salary grade four (4)

Section 5. FUNCTIONS OF MIPAO.

- 5.1. To act as an extension arm of the Chief Executive in implementing direction, plans and programs for economic development of the cultural group community;
- 5.2. To lead the promotion and protection of rights of the indigenous cultural communities;
- 5.3. To facilitate the resolution of conflicts, problems that may arise in the community;
- 5.4. Serve as complaint and assistance desk in whatever interests and concerns a member wishes to present to;
- 5.5. To guide the Indigenous Peoples Organization in implementing programs for cultural development;
- 5.6. to do other task as may be assigned by the Local Chief Executive;

Section 6. BUDGETARY AND FINANCE REQUIREMENT. All salaries and wages required for the personnel as well as its maintenance and operation cost shall be covered with an appropriation to be included in the

Annual Regular Budget in the amount to be determined by the concerned personnel designated by the Local Chief Executive for the purpose.

Section 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision of this ordinance or part thereof declared unconstitutional or unlawful, the other parts not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any part of provisions of this ordinance in conflict with or contrary to the existing ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after 15 days a copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board in the municipal hall and two other conspicuous places.

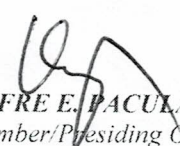
