ORDINANCE NO. 9, s. 2011

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MUNICIPAL BIRTHING FACILITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be called "An Ordinance establishing the Municipal Birthing Facility of Dumingag, Zamboanga Del Sur."

Section 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

It is the policy of this Local Government Unit to have a paradigm shift in maternal and newborn care from "risk approach" to "emergency obstetric care approach", an approach that considers all pregnant women to deliver at accredited birthing facilities assisted by skilled birth attendants for the purpose of providing assured quality birthing services, thus ensuring safety of the life of both the mother and child.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

In this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

- SBA - Skilled Birth Attendants are the following: Licensed Medical Doctor, Licensed Nurse, Licensed Midwife/RHM.
- RHM - Rural Health Midwife
- RHU - Rural Health Unit/Municipal Health Office
- MHO - Municipal Health Officer
- BEmONC - Basic Emergency Obstetric and Newborn Care
- MBF - Municipal Birthing Facility
- Birthing Facility - a place where deliveries are performed.; BEmONC facility; Government Hospitals; Private Hospitals accredited by DOH; Lying-in Clinics accredited by DOH; Birthing Homes accredited by DOH
- MCP - Maternal and Childcare Package
- PHIC - Philippine Health Insurance Corporation; PhilHealth
- DOH - Department of Health

Section 4. COVERAGE.

The MBF shall serve those who have prenatal records in health centers within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Dumingag. In emergency cases, MBF may accept non-residents of the municipality.

Section 5. STAFFING AND MANAGEMENT.

The MBF shall be administered and operated by the RHU personnel namely:

- a. MHO - overall Officer-in-Charge of the MBF
- b. RHMs - who serve as regular personnel to attend the delivery

- c. Nurse - who serves as senior staff or team leader of the regular personnel of MBF
- d. Casual/Job Order Licensed Midwife/Licensed Nurse - who is assisting the regular personnel of the MBF
- e. Other Medical Doctors - who may serve as consultants to assess the condition of the patient for further management

Section 6. OVERTIME.

Availment of overtime of the MBF personnel shall conform with the existing rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission and Magna Carta Law for the Health Personnel.

Section 7. SERVICE FEE.

PhilHealth Member patients are free from charges for the first four (4) births. However, non-PhilHealth member patients have to purchase/pay the supplies and medicines used during the delivery.

Section 8. DISTRIBUTION OF THE MCP REIMBURSEMENT FUND PAID BY PHILHEALTH.

In compliance of PhilHealth Circular No. 39 s-2009, MCP reimbursement fund paid by PhilHealth will be divided as follows:

- Fifty percent (50%) of the MCP reimbursement fund paid by PHIC shall be divided among the RHU Personnel who rendered actual services at the time of delivery, and postpartum care.
- The other fifty percent (50%) of the MCP reimbursement fund paid by PHIC shall be for the facility, supplies, medicines and other services intended for maternal and child care.

Section 9. CONTINUING EDUCATION AND ADVOCACY PROGRAM.

The MHO shall include in their annual plans and programs the continuing education and advocacy program regarding the benefits of the MBF to ensure the safety of the life of both mother and child.

Section 10. COMPLIANCE OF MINIMUM REQUIREMENT.

The Local Chief Executive (LCE) shall see to it through the recommendation of the MHO to comply the minimum requirement set by DOH regarding the operations of the birthing facility.

Section 11. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All resolutions, ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, whose provisions are in conflict with or contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby deemed repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provisions of this ordinance or any part thereof be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other provisions or any part thereof not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

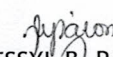
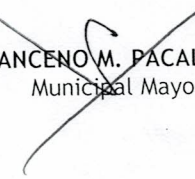
Section 13. EFFECTIVITY.

This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its approval and after due compliance with publication requirements.
