AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL PROJECT MONITORING COMMITTEE (MPMC) OF MUNICIPALITY OF DUMINGAG, ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 376 s. 1989, as amended by E.O. No. 93, s. 1993, established the Regional Project Monitoring and Evaluation System (RPMES) to facilitate project evaluation and monitoring at the National, Regional, Provincial, and City//Municipal levels;

WHEREAS, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2004-78, Series of 2004 was issued to facilitate the organization and reconstitution of Project Monitoring Committees (PMCs) nationwide and to further strengthen the roles of said Committee in ensuring transparency and accountability in the implementation of Local Development Programs and Projects;

WHEREAS, to enjoin Local Government Officials to organize Local PMCs (LPMCs) in their respective areas of jurisdiction or reconstitute said LPMCs if already existing, DILG MC No. 2019-188, with the title, "Organization or Reconstitution of Sub-Regional Project Monitoring Committees (PMCs)," was then promulgated;

NOW THEREFORE, I, GERRY T. PAGLINAWAN, Mayor of the Municipality of Dumingag, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the adaptation of the reconstitution of the Local Project Monitoring Committee of the Municipality of Dumingag.

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION

The Municipall Project Monitoring Committee shall be composed of, but not limited to the following:

- Chairperson : **The LCE shall appoint the chairperson from any the LDC nominees or the members of the PMC**
- Secretariat : **AL REY L. ESTILLORE, Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator**
- Members :
- 1. ETHEL TROBANOS, Municipal Local Government Operations Officer - DILG**
 - 2. NGO/ PO REP.**
 - 3. NGO/ PO from LDC**
 - 4. 4 PMC members appointed by the LCE from among five nominees of the LDC**
 - 5. VILMA ESTRERA, Lower Timonan Women's Organization**
 - 6. EDILTRUDES CHICOGO, Sinamay Weaver's Association**
 - 7. ESTRELLA VILLAYER, Mahayahay Women's Association**

The Local Project Monitoring Committee may, from time to time, call on any concerned agencies or sectors as it may deem necessary.

SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS

The Project Monitoring Committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- Provide up-to-date and relevant information on the over-all status of project implementation at each level for timely program/project adjustments, planning and budget allocation;
- Ascertain issues and concerns which impede project implementation for remedial actions at the City Development Council and Committee levels and to elevate unresolved issues and problems at the appropriate offices and institutions at the city level for resolution and final action;
- Institutionalize problem solving session (PSS) as a mechanism to address issues and concerns related to the implementation of programs, projects and activities (PPAs); and
- Assess and ascertain whether development programs and projects implemented are delivering results in support of city development goals and plans as well as regional and national development thrusts and priorities.

SECTION 3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

The programs, projects and activities (PPAs) to be monitored by the Project Monitoring Committee shall include all foreign and nationally-funded projects; including funds directly downloaded to the city which are implemented within the Local Government Unit (LGU). It shall also monitor PPAs funded from the Annual Development Fund (ADF) and locally generated resources, including those that are funded at the barangay level.

SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT

The Office of the City Planning and Development Coordinator shall serve as the secretariat of the local PMC as mandated in Executive Order No. 93, series of 1993 issued by the President of the Philippines.

- a. Prepare lists of schedules of all PPAs to be monitored;
- b. Process reports of implementers on the status of project and implementation for the information of the Project Monitoring Committee (PMC);
- c. Identify problems, concerns and verify information for appropriate actions;
- d. Prepare and disseminate periodic project monitoring report on the status of project implementation;
- e. Provide technical services and documentation of proceedings of PMC meetings and activities; and
- f. Prepare reports and such other assistance as may be required in the discharge of its functions.

The operational expenses and other related expenses of the PMC shall be chargeable to the approved budget of the Municipal Local Government of Dumingag, subject to the approval of the PMC in consonance to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

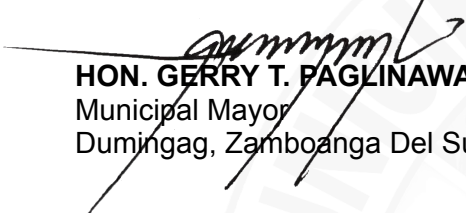
SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE
